Subject: Ordinance – Fire: Ventilation Vehicle Transfer from Point Pleasant Fire Protection District

Attached is an Ordinance captioned:

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation of a Chevy 5500 Super VAC Ventilation Unit originally valued at approximately \$194,710 from the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District to be used by the Cincinnati Fire Department.

Approval of this Ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation of a Chevy 5500 Super VAC Ventilation Unit originally valued at approximately \$194,710 from the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District to be used by the Cincinnati Fire Department.

The ventilation vehicle was originally purchased with Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) resources administered by the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to be used for regional preparedness in designated areas.

CFD will utilize the vehicle to mitigate heat, smoke, or contaminants on scenes. The vehicle will be utilized for the purposes permitted under the original grant agreement, including making the vehicle available to the region in accordance with existing Mutual Fire Aid Agreements.

The acceptance of this donation does not require local matching resources and there are no new FTEs associated with this donation.

Acceptance of this donation is in accordance with the “Live” goal to “[c]reate a more livable community” as described on page 156 of Plan Cincinnati (2012).

The Administration recommends passage of this Ordinance.
