WHEREAS, Officer Lisa Johnson received the Matthew Shepard award in 2021, and has been honored by Cincinnati Pride for her work, and recognized for going beyond the call of duty in serving her community; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:
