## **Community Engagement**

Over 1,240 responses were submitted to our online surveys. The following priority corridors received the most support from respondents:

- Downtown/OTR/West End Central Parkway (Plum to Eggleston)
- Westside Lick Run + Dunham to Rapid Run
- Northwest College Hill-Northside Connector
- Northeast Madison (Wasson to Kennedy)
- Uptown MLK (Clifton to Harvey)
- Eastside Beechmont Ave (Ranchvale to corp line)

### **Community Engagement**

#### **Key themes shared by respondents**

- Support for efforts to expand bike infrastructure
- Desire for facilities that are protected or separated from vehicular traffic, particularly on corridors with high vehicular volumes and speeds.
- Need for increased maintenance of existing facilities




# **Plan Updates**



- Strategy: Always try to build an All Ages and Abilities facility – if that's not feasible, then work down the pyramid.
























