RESOLUTION NO. 72 - 2022

RECOGNIZING June 21, 2022 as “Make Music Cincinnati Day” in Cincinnati.

WHEREAS, Make Music Cincinnati is an annual one-day festival on the first day of summer that celebrates the ability of everyone to make music; and

WHEREAS, Make Music Cincinnati is a day of music-making in public spaces throughout the Greater Cincinnati area, all completely free for musicians and audiences alike; and

WHEREAS, Make Music Cincinnati launched on June 21, 2019, inspired by France’s national musical holiday “Fete de la Musique,” which began in 1982 and is now an international phenomenon that takes place on the Summer Solstice in more than 1,000 cities in 120 countries; and

WHEREAS, Make Music Cincinnati joins a national group of over 98 Make Music North American cities providing 3,334 free concerts at over 1,000 locations including New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Miami, Madison, Cleveland, and Philadelphia; and

WHEREAS, Make Music Cincinnati involves hundreds of musicians, bands, and ensembles from a diverse array of styles and genres, including everything from classical, jazz, and blues to folk, pop, rock, and world music; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cincinnati encourages all citizens to celebrate the joy of making music; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor and this Council hereby recognize June 21, 2022 as “Make Music Day” in Cincinnati.

Section 2. That this resolution be spread upon the minutes of Council.
