**AUTHORIZING** the City Manager to accept in-kind donations of various plants to benefit and improve City parks and restoration services for the Black Brigade monument valued at approximately \$77,845.75.

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Parks Foundation intends to donate various plants to benefit and improve City parks as well as restoration services for the Black Brigade monument located in Smale Riverfront Park; and

WHEREAS, the total value of the in-kind donations is approximately \$77,845.75; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of this in-kind donation does not require matching funds, and there are no new FTEs/full time equivalents associated with this donation; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of in-kind donations to benefit and improve City parks is in accordance with the "Sustain" goal to "[p]reserve our natural and built environment" as described on page 193 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept in-kind donations from the

Cincinnati Parks Foundation of various plants to benefit and improve City parks and restoration

services for the Black Brigade monument valued at approximately \$77,845.75, as outlined in

Attachment A.

Section 2. That the proper City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and

proper to carry out the terms of Section 1.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
