- Working with residents engaged in hoarding to decrease clutter in their homes
- Designated trash pick-ups created so residents can work with Brooke to eliminate items weekly to make homes more livable
- Bi-weekly meetings with Brooke to review progress and to continue to offer in-home support






## Improved Response to Encampments

- Decreasing the presence of CPD
- Increasing the presence of the CMO
- Incorporating a more humancentered approach
- Offering housing, social services, and time to relocate
