BOLD has served the Greater Cincinnati region for 30 years and trained over 1,400 community leaders to serve hundreds of nonprofits.

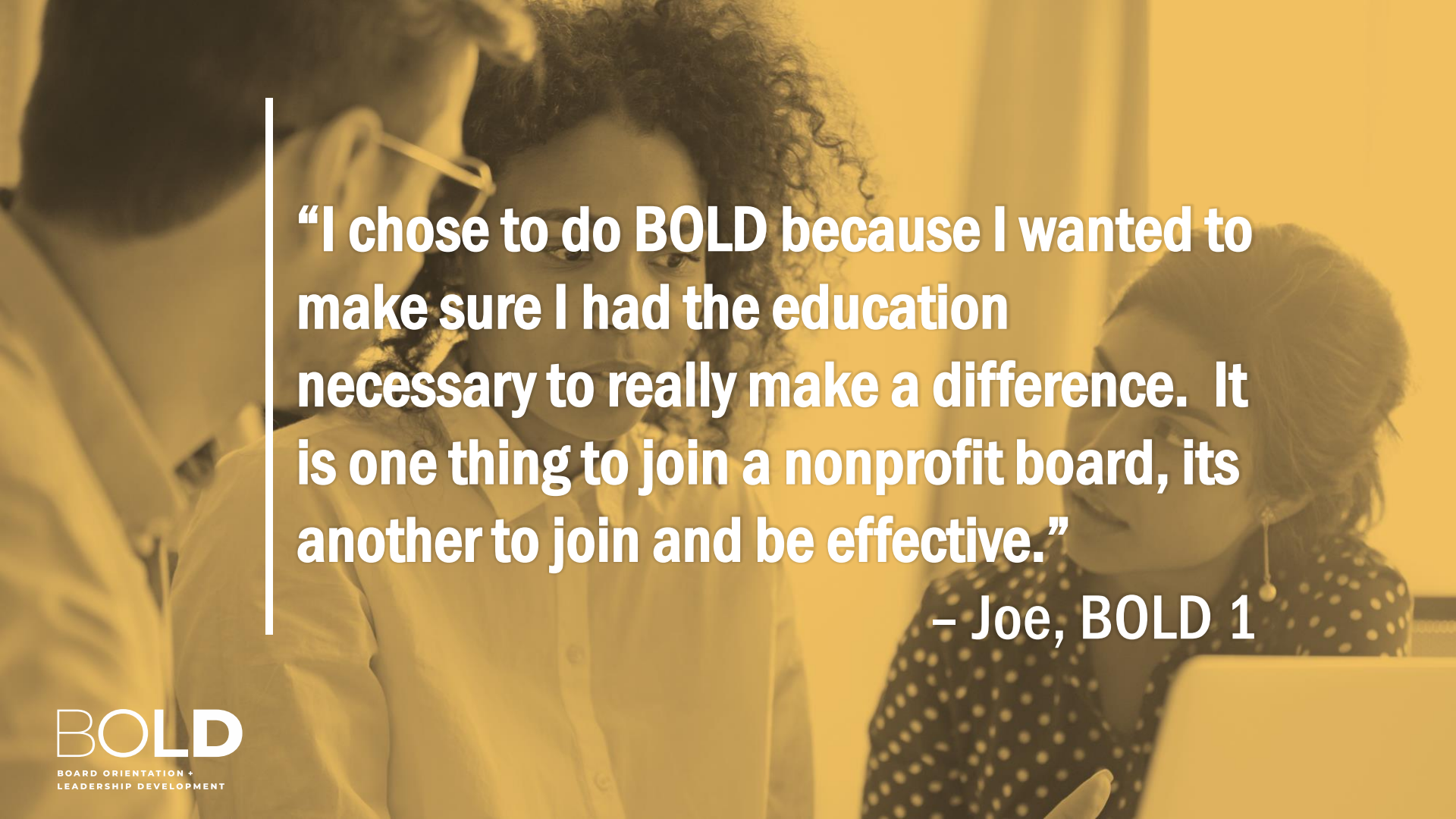
1991: VLDP Program Launched
