RECOGNIZING AND HONORING the Cincinnati Bearcats men’s track and field team for its victory in the 2023 American Athletic Conference Indoor Track and Field Championship and for its athletic rigor, teamwork, and sportsmanship, and Head Coach Susan Seaton and assistants Chris Wineberg, Nadine Faustin-Parker, Sam Kranz, Lucas Rothenberger, and Sarah Anderson for their dedication to and leadership of the program.

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Bearcat men’s track and field team won its first American Athletic Conference (“AAC”) championship title since 2004 and first indoor conference title since 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Bearcats defeated six teams and scored 143 points; and

WHEREAS, the Bearcats claimed four individual event titles, winning the shot put, weight throw, 400 meters, and the distance medley relay; and

WHEREAS, the Bearcats men’s track and field coaches were honored as the Men’s AAC Staff of the Year for their success; and



BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:


