## MOTION

WE MOVE that the City Council allocate funds in the amount of \$300,000 ~~from the Municipal Public Equivalent Fund 491 (40b) or another eligible~~ from a fund identified by the administration to support capital improvements for the Save-A-Lot Grocery in Roselawn.

## STATEMENT
