Attached is an Emergency Ordinance captioned:

**MODIFYING** Chapter 307, "Classified Compensation Schedules," of the Cincinnati Municipal Code by **AMENDING** Section 819 to move the classification of and new salary schedule plan for Alternative Response Community Service Officer from Division 0 to Division D1.

The AFSCME bargaining unit and City of Cincinnati through a Letter of Agreement (LOA) agreed to move the Alternative Response Community Service Officer classification to Salary Division 1-AFSCME bargaining unit. Upon approval and implementation of the new salary schedule plan for Alternative Response Community Service Officers, the affected employees will be moved into the appropriate salary schedule plan as indicated in the LOA between AFSCME and the City; The Administration recommends passage of this Emergency Ordinance.
