Findings:	<p>Officers conducted an inspection at Dusmesh restaurant and advised the owner that the restaurant was operating under unsanitary conditions. There was open container of raw and cook chicken on the floor and in the area where the mop drain sink was located. There was raw beef sitting on the sink that appeared to have been sitting for an unreasonable amount of time. Under that sink where the beef was sitting, was wet and dried blood that had drained/leaked from the sink and rested on the floor below. All the storage areas were filled with clutter and food particles that had not appeared to have been cleaned for a while. The industrial size bags of produce were sitting directly on the floor, stairwell, and rear entry way of the restaurant in unsanitary conditions. There was also a bag of produce in an outside storage area semi covered, directly exposed to rodents and elements of outdoors. The basement storage freezer was covered with food residue from being opened and closed and not properly cleaned. The dry foods stored in the basement was left in open container exposed to all the basement elements. The floors were all slippery and covered with food particles. The containers had dried food residue and blood on them appearing to be cross contaminated. The kitchen and storage areas were not fit for operation and appeared to be a hazard to public health and safety. With the observed violations, a complaint was referred to the Health Department for review. Photos taken.</p>
