







Trauma & Resilience: A Life Course Perspective



- SCR 9: To urge the state of Ohio to take steps to address housing inequality (10/5/2021)
- **SB 317**: Prohibit housing discrimination based on housing assistance vouchers and public assistance (3/23/2022)
- **HB186**: Enacting First-time Home Buyer Savings Act (3/9/2021).
 - Passed the House, referred to Senate Ways and Means
- **HB560**: Authorize tax credit for certain affordable rental housing (2/7/2022)





