

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept and appropriate additional grant resources of up to \$89,597.20 from the Carbon Reduction Program funds awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, as administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ALN 20.205), to capital improvement program project account no. 980x233x252317, “EV Charging OTR Garages Grant PID 122817,” to provide additional resources to install electric vehicle charging infrastructure in parking garages located in Over-The-Rhine and the Central Business District; and **AUTHORIZING** the Director of Finance to deposit the additional grant resources into capital improvement program project account no. 980x233x252317, “EV Charging OTR Garages Grant PID 122817.”

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2025, Council passed Ordinance No. 201-2025, which authorized the City Manager to apply for, accept, and appropriate grant resources of up to \$895,972 from the Carbon Reduction Program funds awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (“OKI”), as administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ALN 20.205), to capital improvement program project account no. 980x233x252317, “EV Charging OTR Garages Grant PID 122817”; and

WHEREAS, OKI has administratively approved a ten percent increase in grant funding, totaling \$89,597.20; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the additional grant resources requires no local matching funds, and no new FTEs/full time equivalents are associated with acceptance of these additional grant resources; and

WHEREAS, the installation of electric vehicle charging infrastructure is in accordance with the “Sustain” goal to “[b]ecome a healthier Cincinnati” and the strategy to “[c]reate a healthy environment and reduce energy consumption” as described on pages 181-185 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept and appropriate additional grant resources of up to \$89,597.20 from the Carbon Reduction Program funds awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI), as administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ALN 20.205), to capital improvement program project account no. 980x233x252317, “EV Charging OTR Garages Grant PID 122817,” to provide additional

resources to install electric vehicle charging infrastructure in parking garages located in Over-The-Rhine and the Central Business District.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is authorized to deposit the additional grant resources into capital improvement program project account no. 980x233x252317, “EV Charging OTR Garages Grant PID 122817.”

Section 3. That the proper City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the provisions of the grant and Sections 1 and 2.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
