

## Sycamore Hotel:

297 fewer calls-for-service annually (-93%)


30 fewer reportable offenses annually (-85%)

## Roselawn (entire neighborhood):

785 fewer calls-for-service annually (-13%)

267 fewer reportable offenses annually (-29%)

## Roselawn Offenses: 2011-2 vs 2014-5




# Place-Based Enforcement

1. **Nuisance Litigation:** Vice activity
2. **Legislative Objection to Annual Liquor Permit Renewals:** substantial interference with public decency, sobriety, peace, or good order would result from the issuance, renewal, transfer of location, or transfer of ownership of the permit and operation
