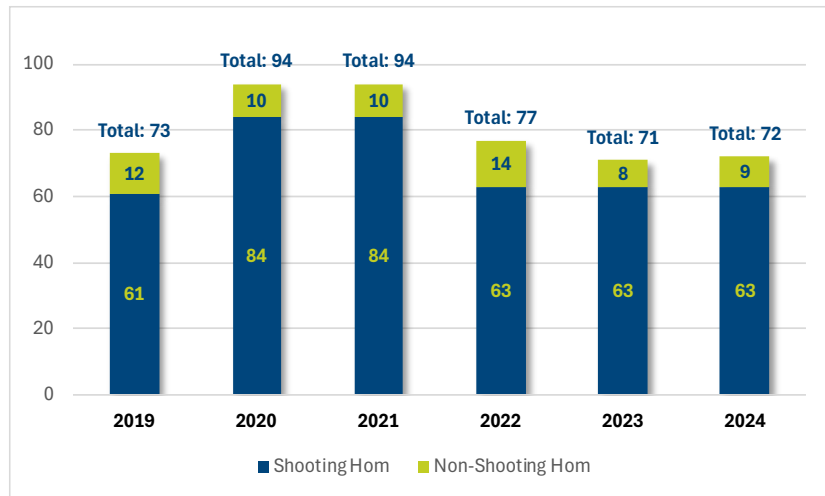

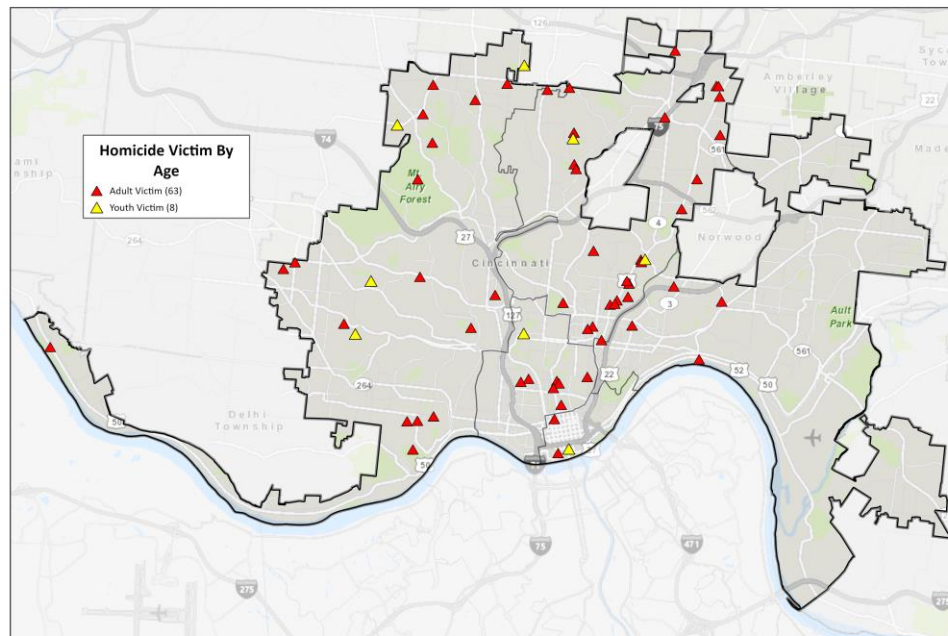

Year-To-Date: January 1 - December 31, 2024

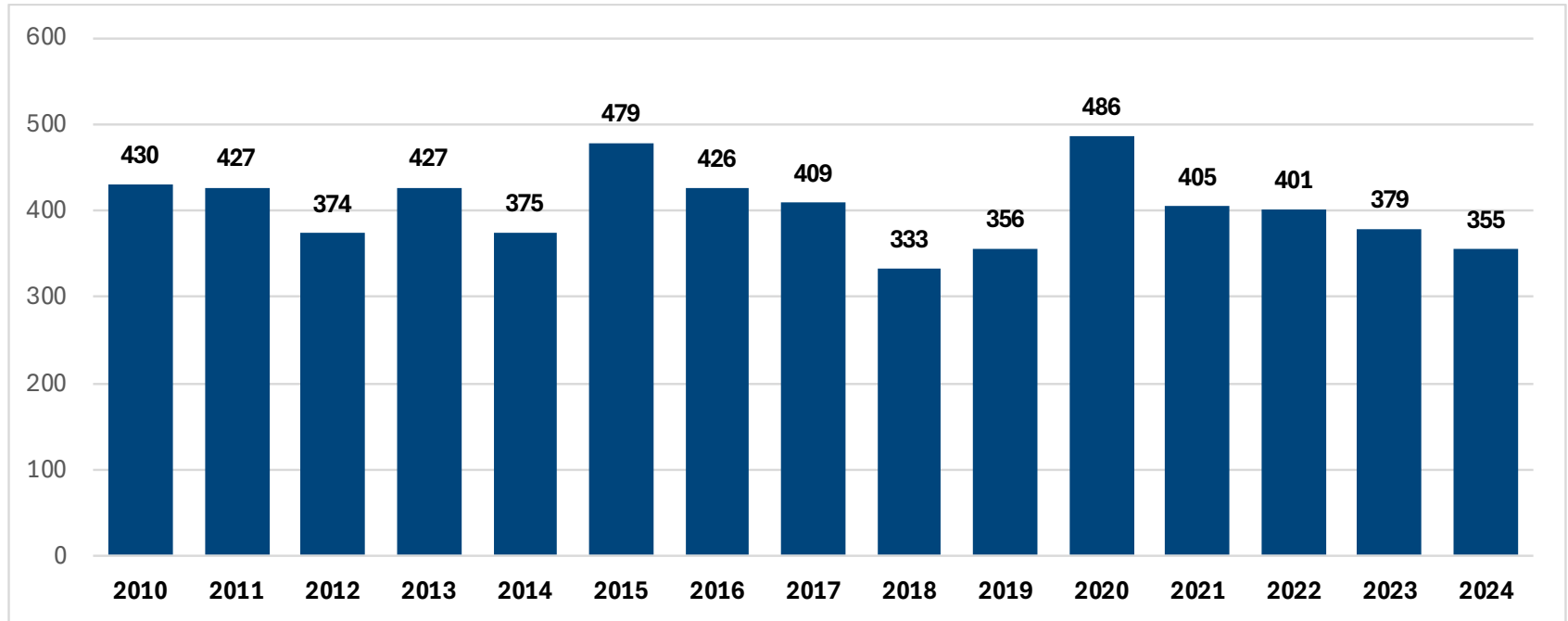

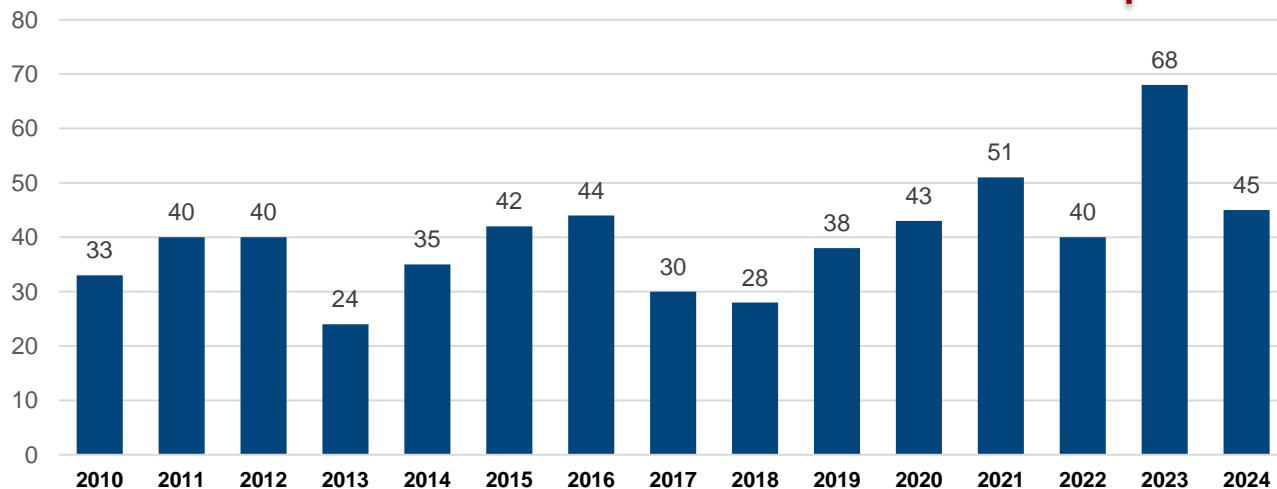

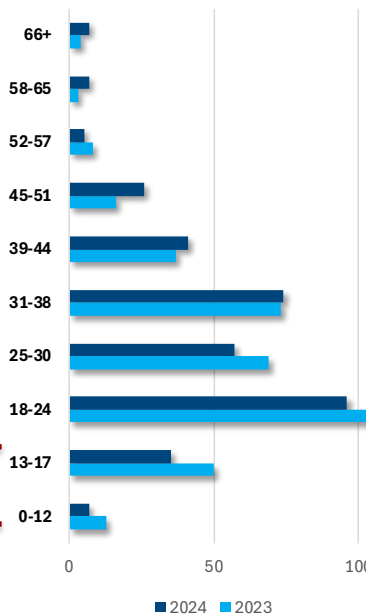

2010 - 2024

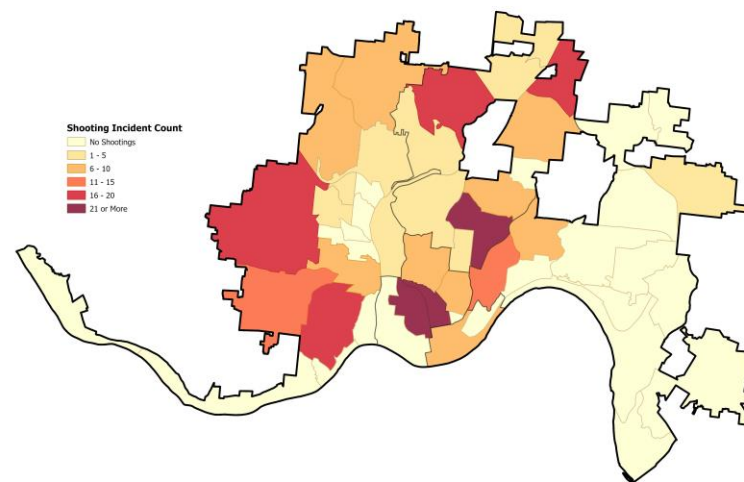
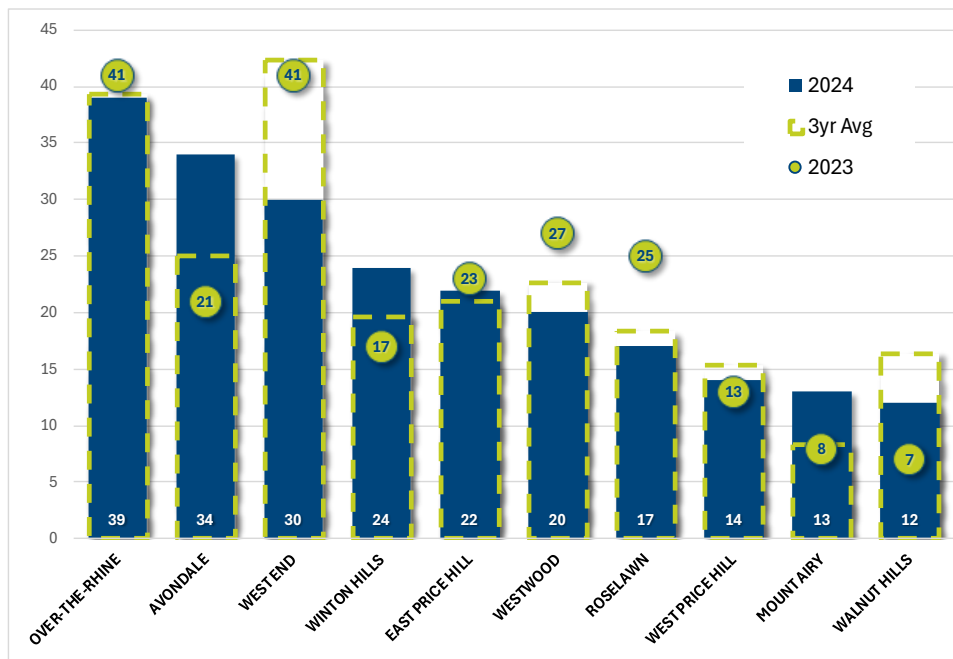


Shooting Victim Count by Age Groupings,

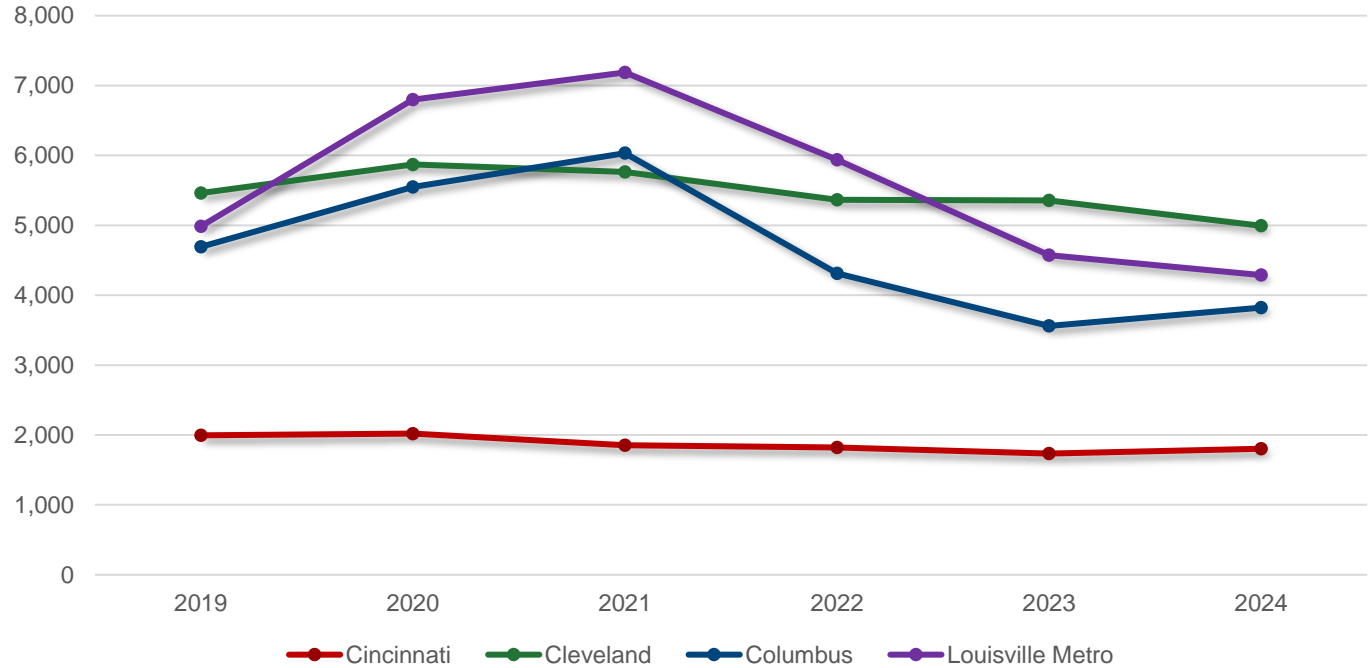

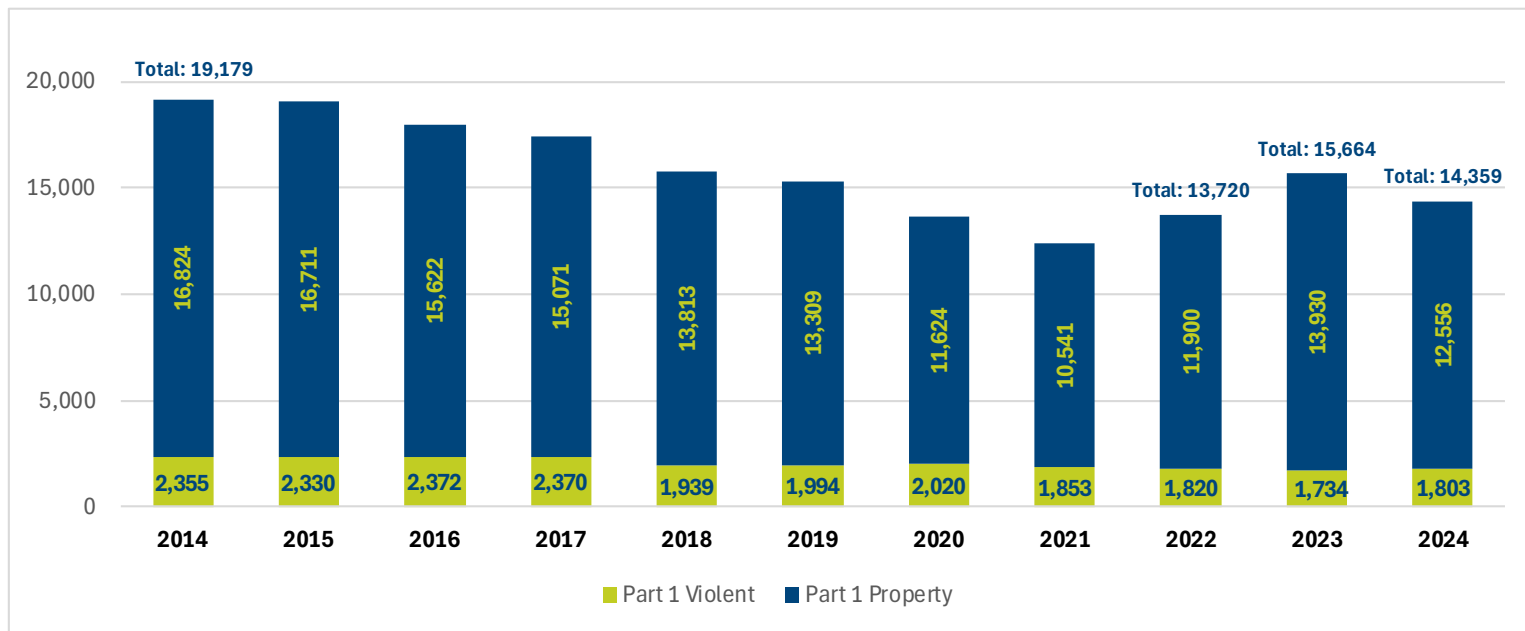

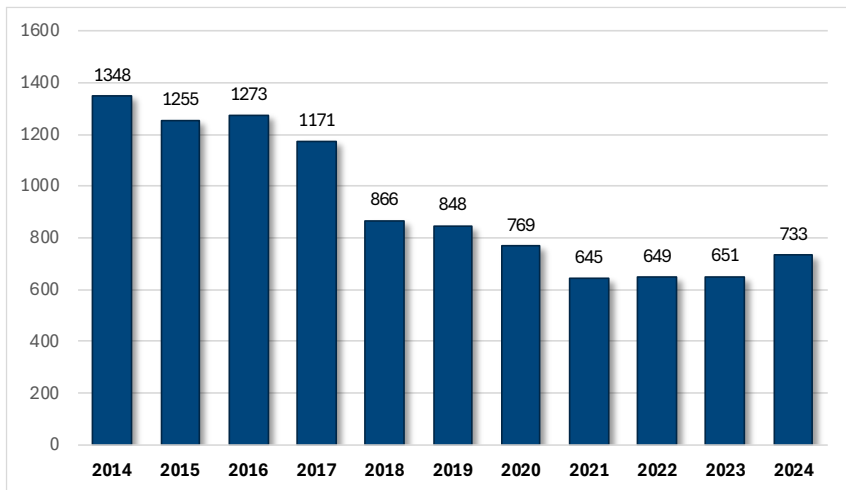

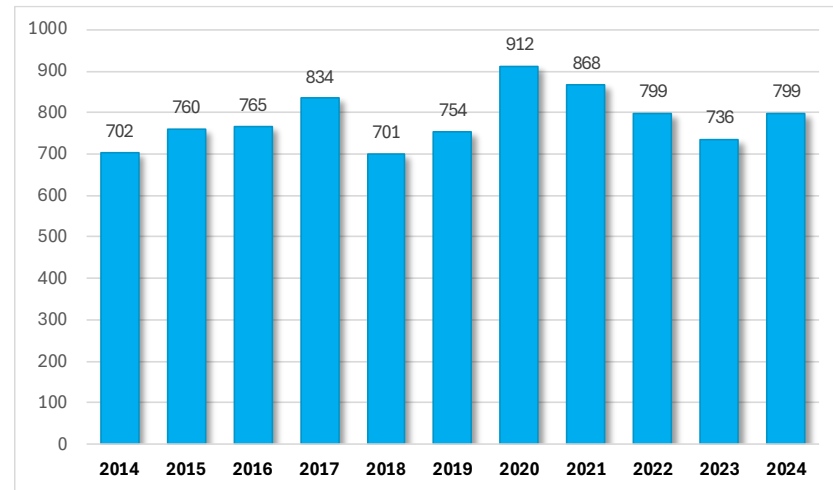

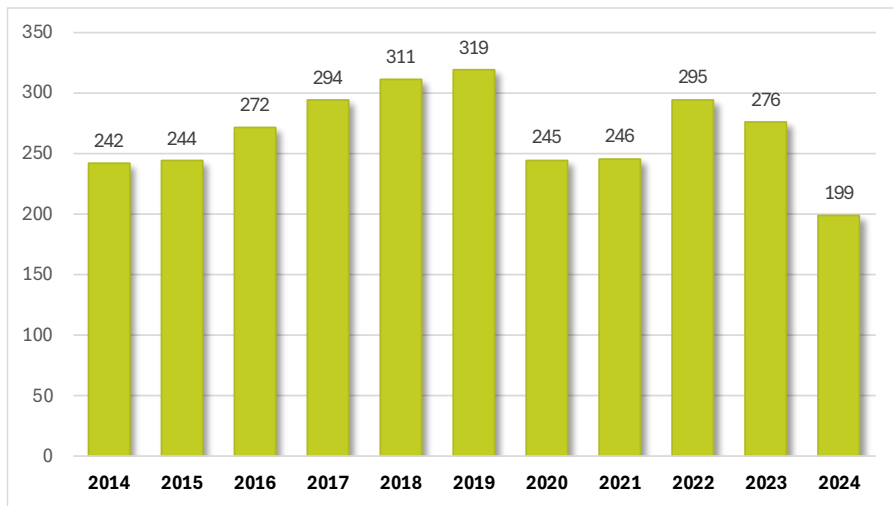

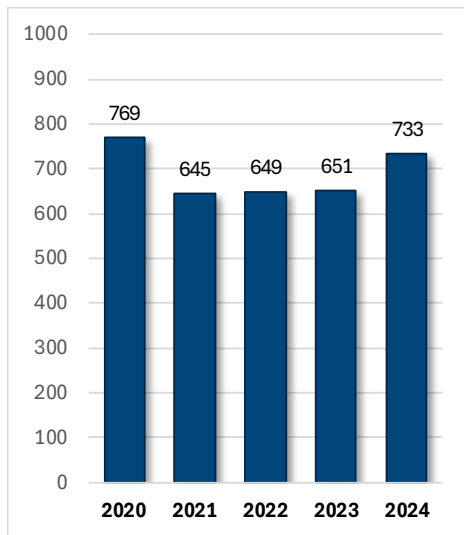

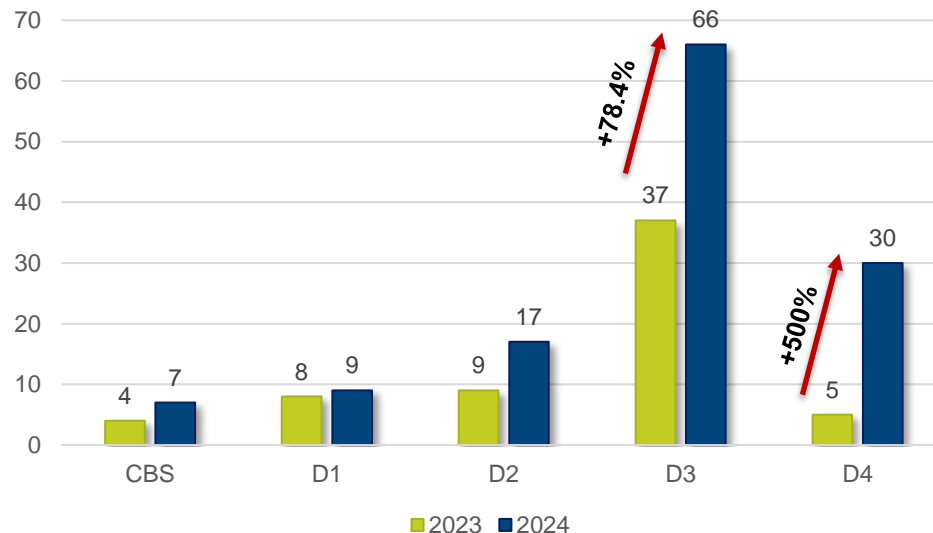

By District



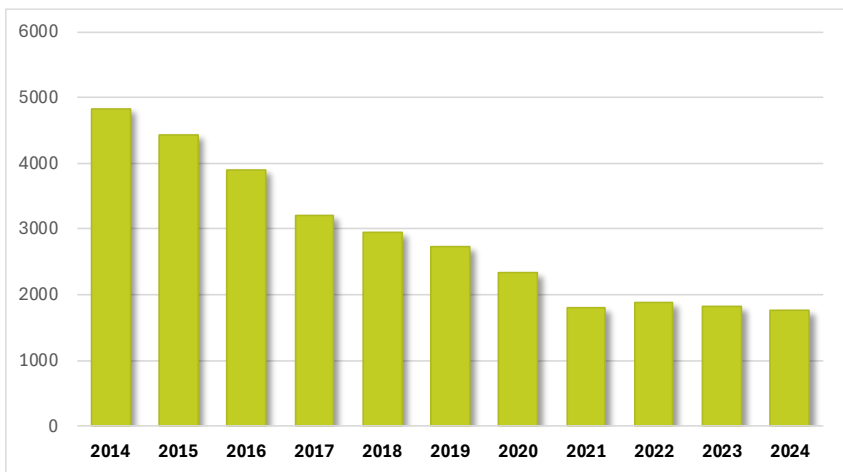

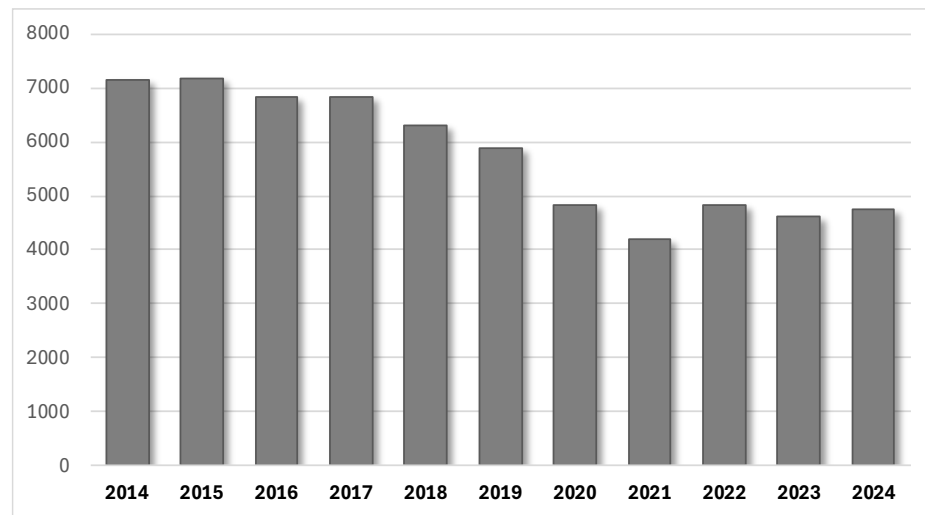

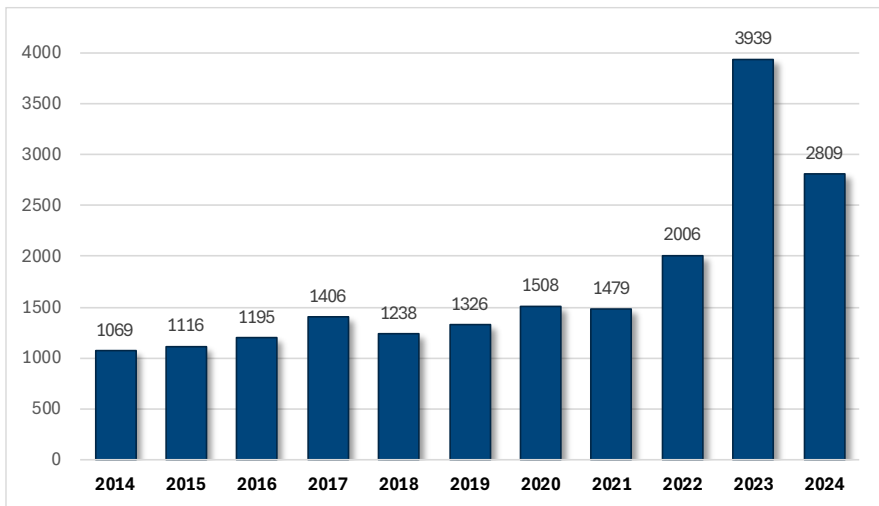

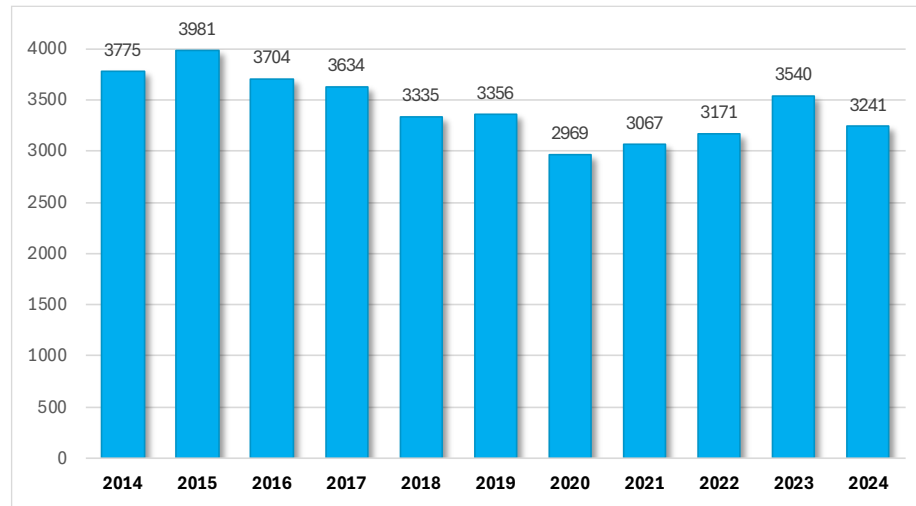

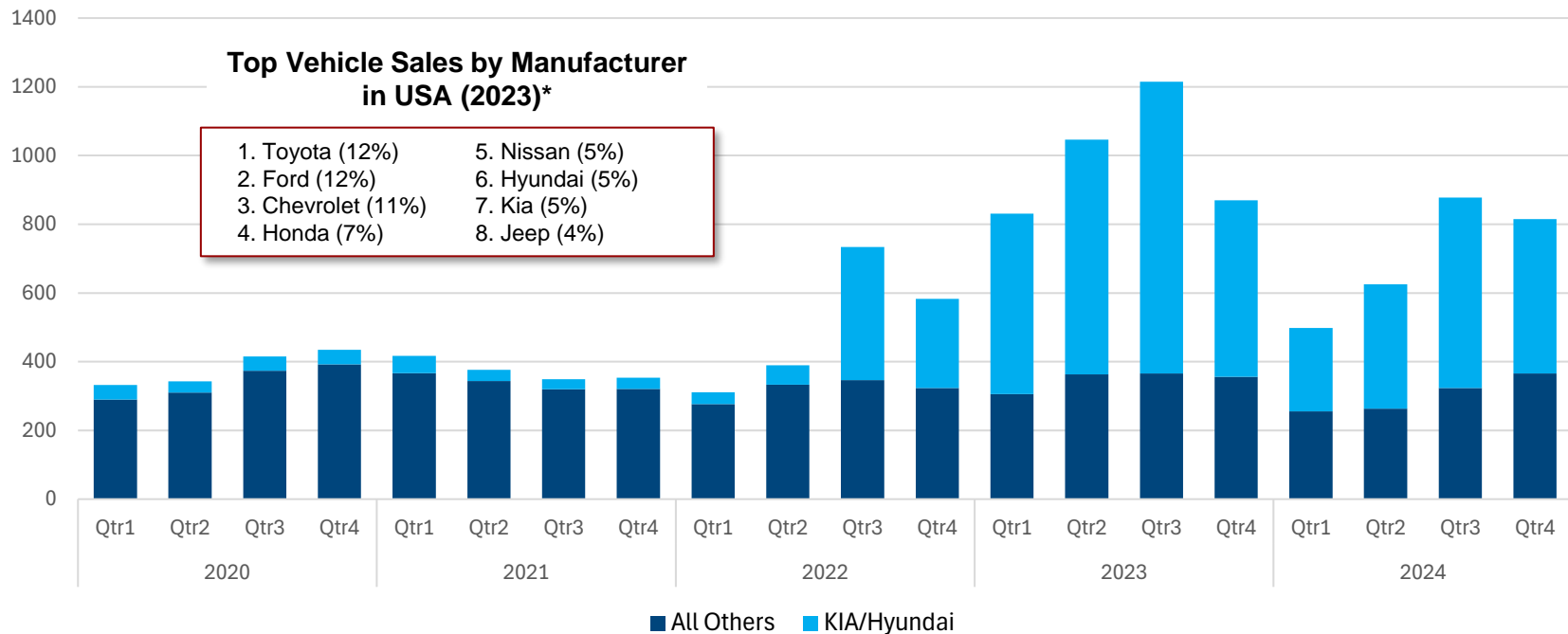

## Affect of KIA/Hyundai Vulnerabilities

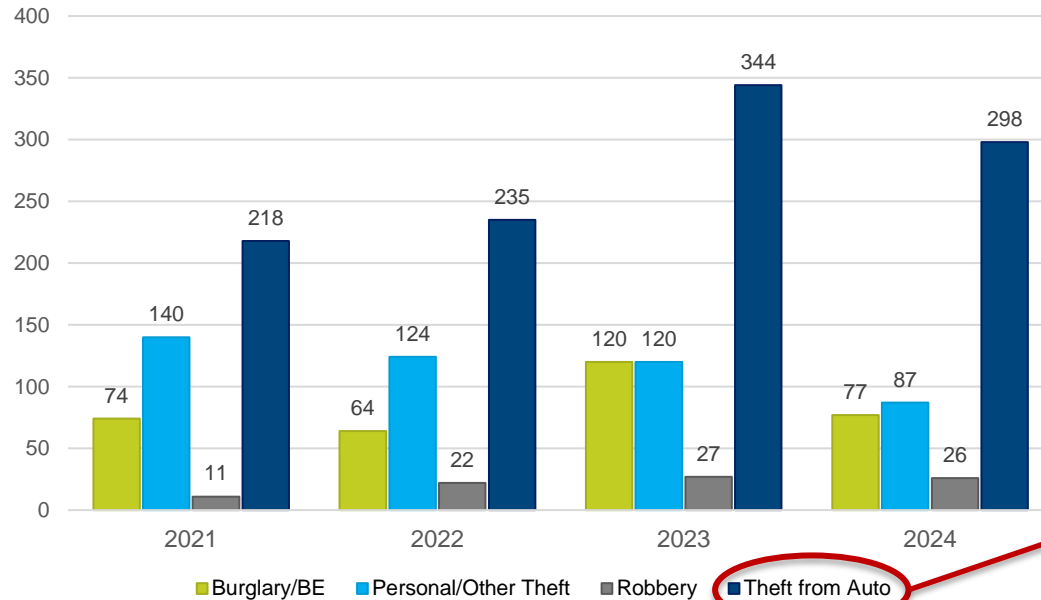

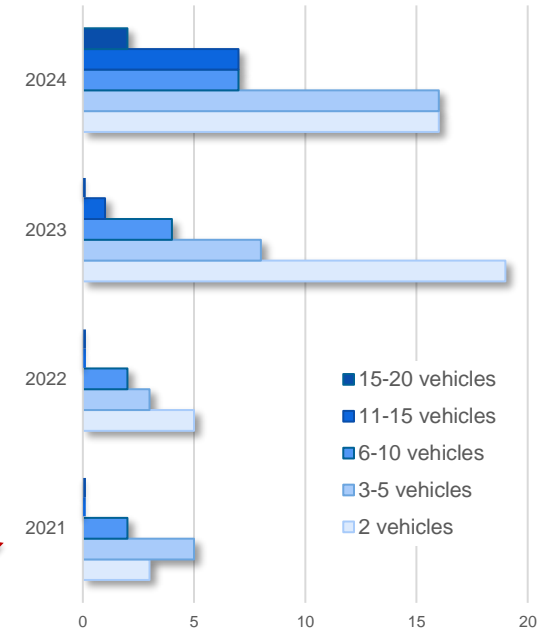

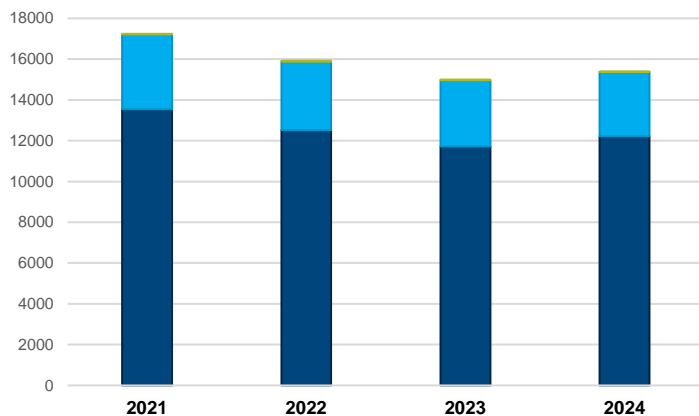

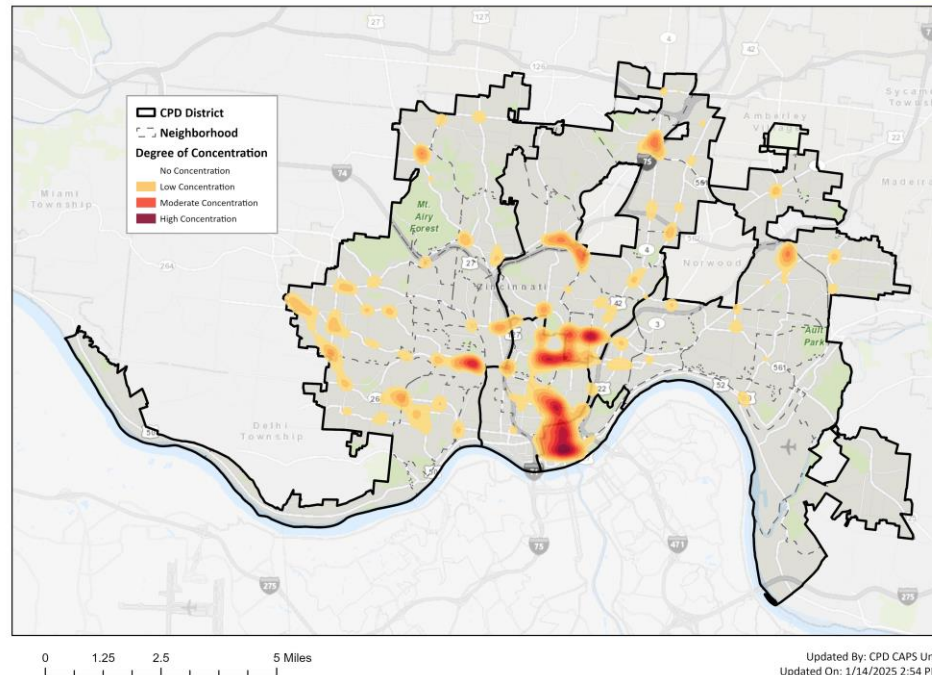

## Distribution of Crashes on City Streets in the City of Cincinnati

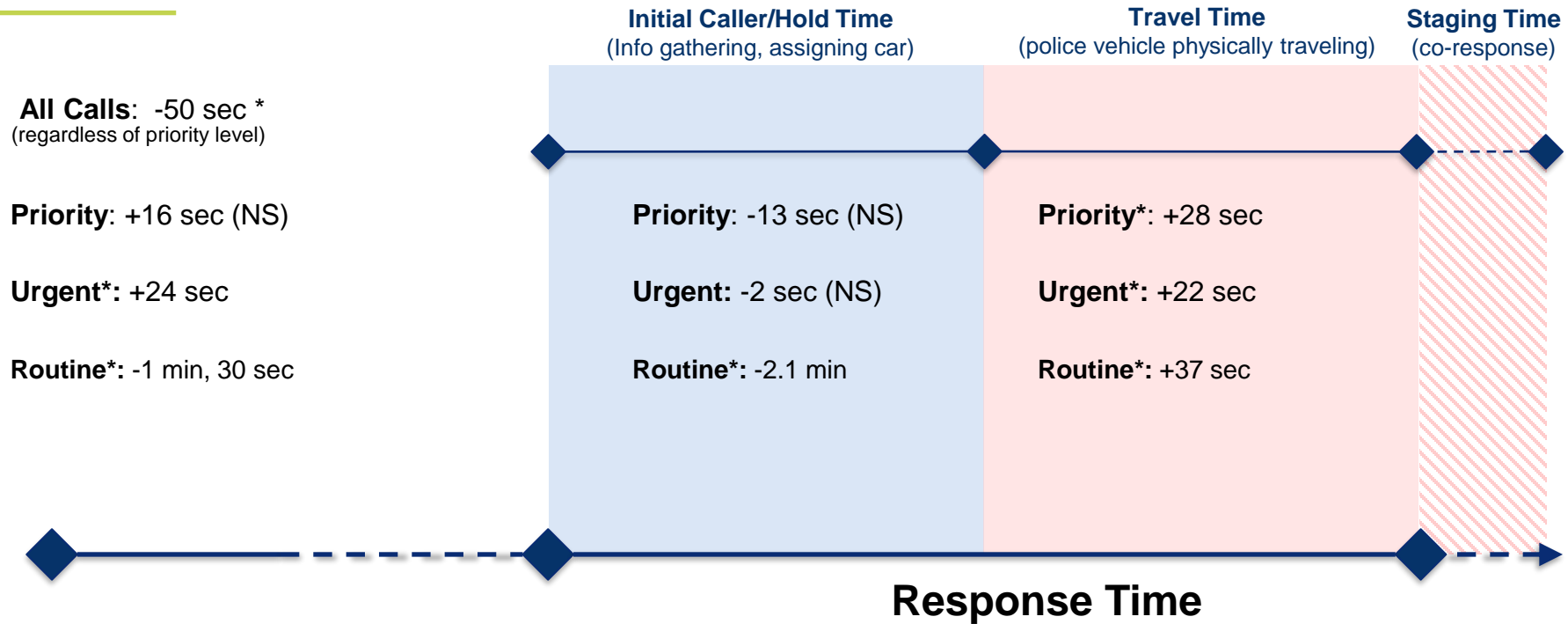

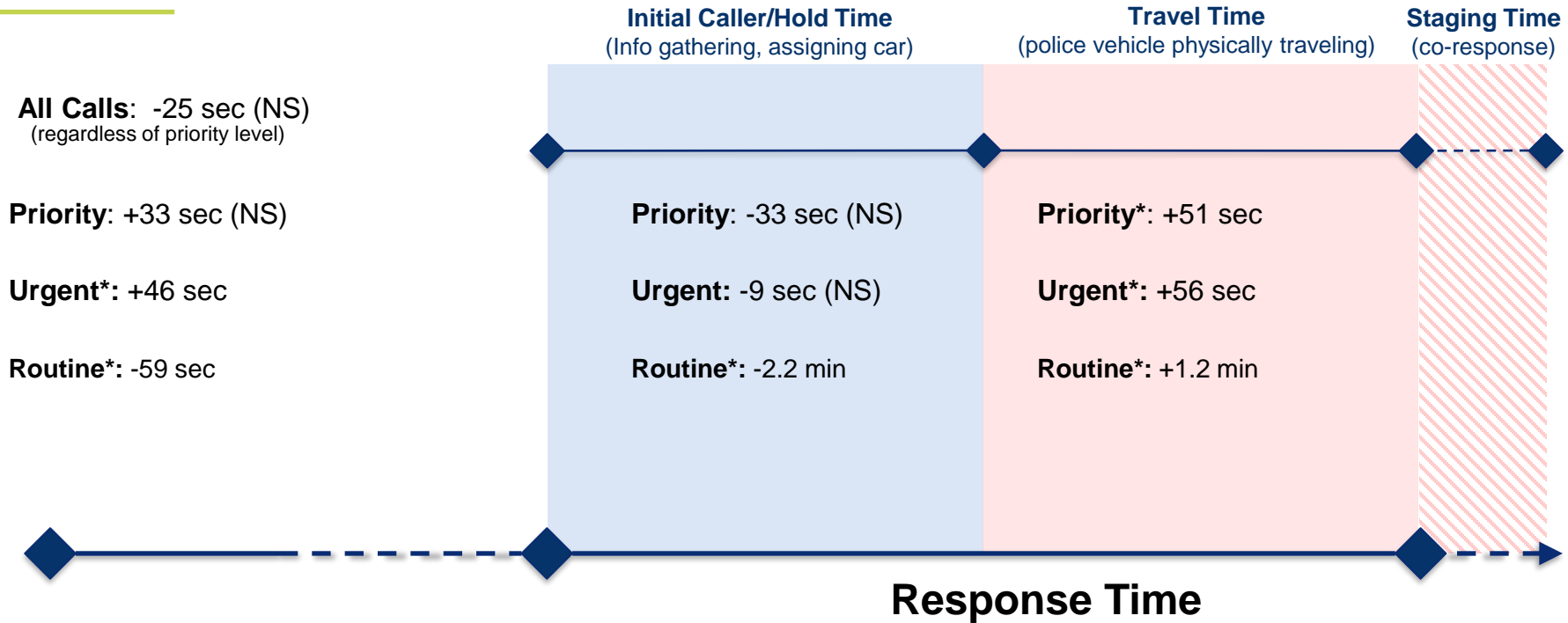

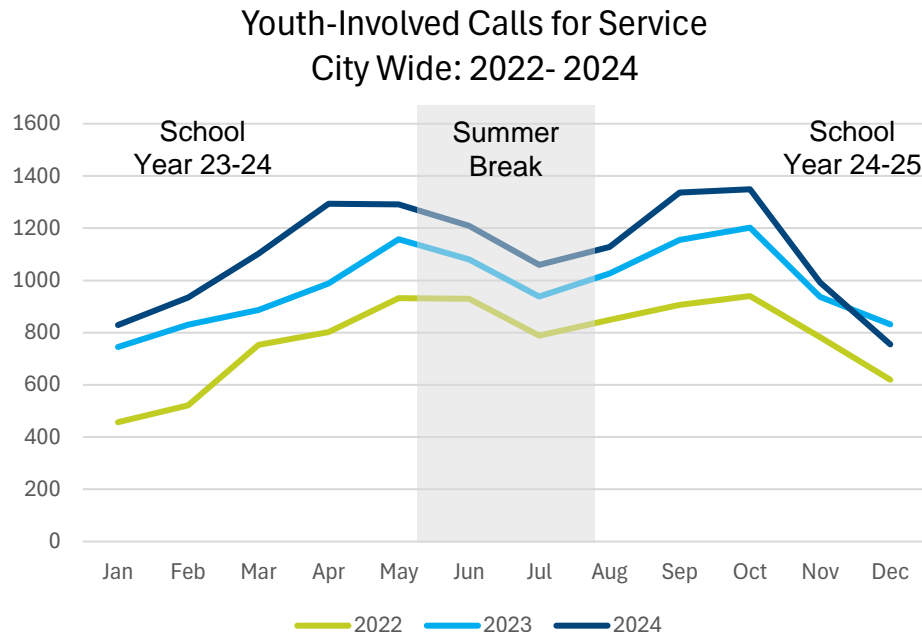

# Youth-Involved Disorder

## Calls for Service, mentioning Youth

### Data queried to pull those calls that mention “youth” or other keywords

- Every year follows the same seasonal trends
- With exception of Dec 2024, every year is slightly higher than last
- Activity and/or travel nodes tend to be spatial hot spots
  - I.e. Transit Centers, Schools, Business or shopping areas

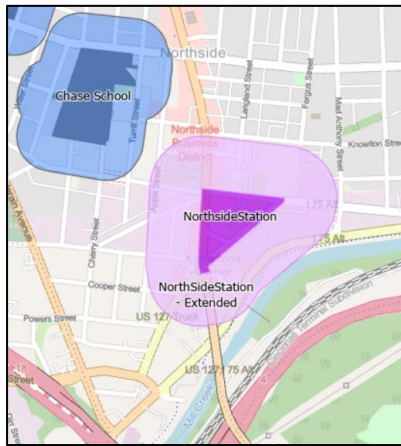

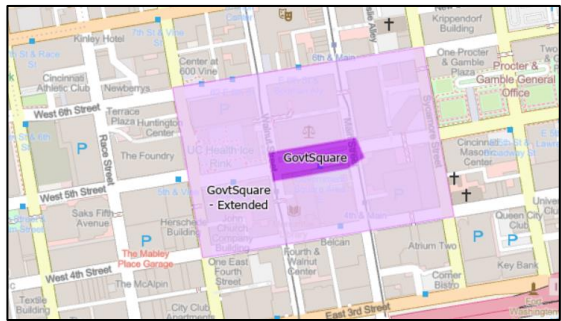
