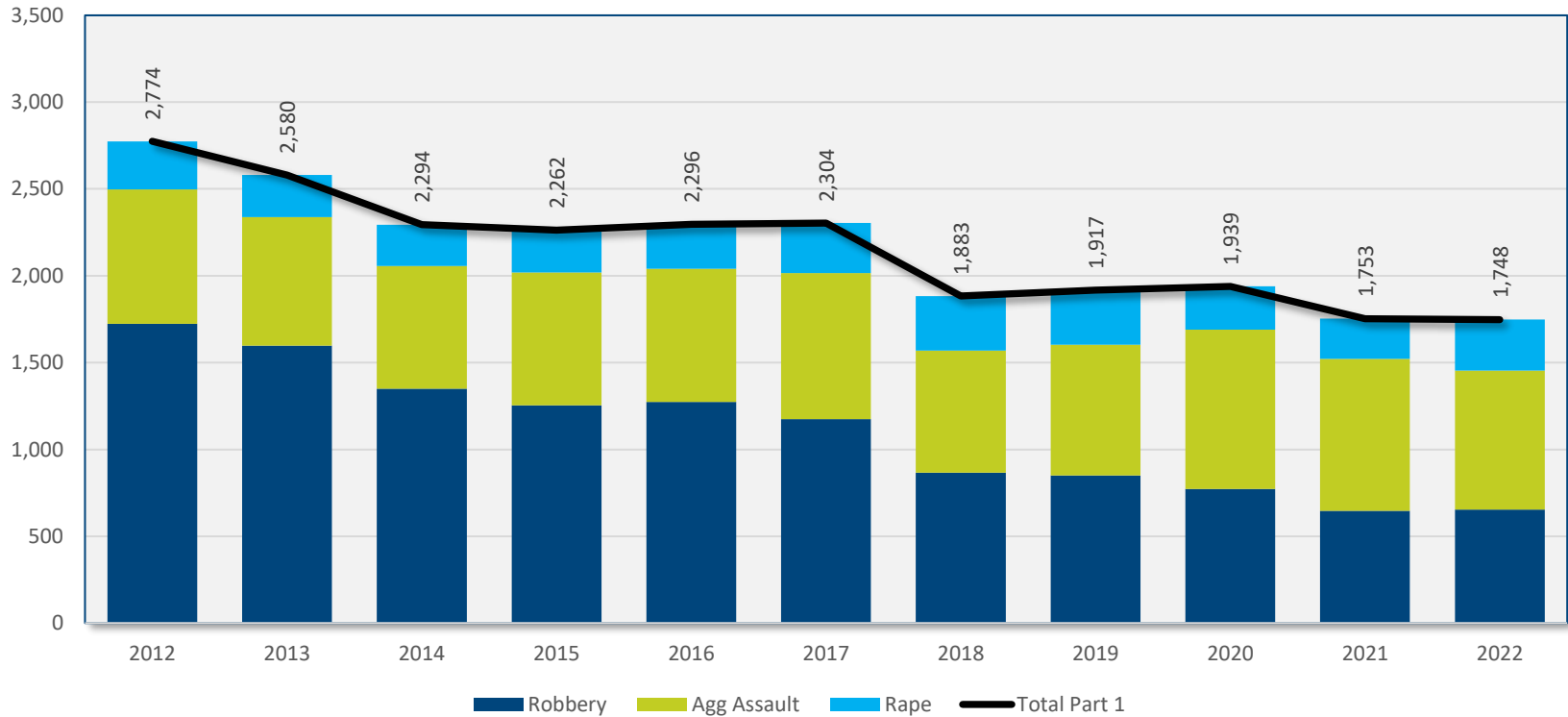

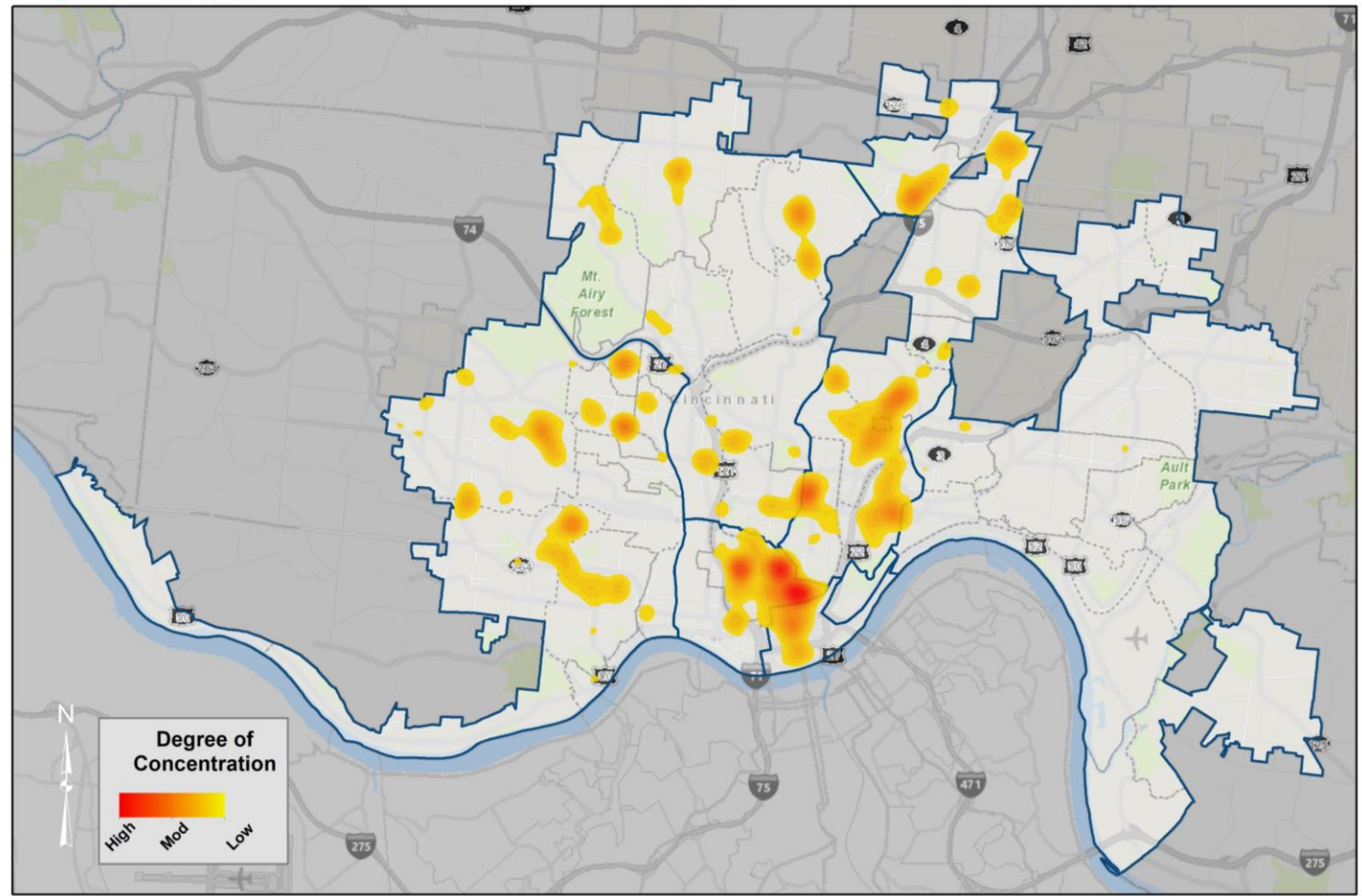

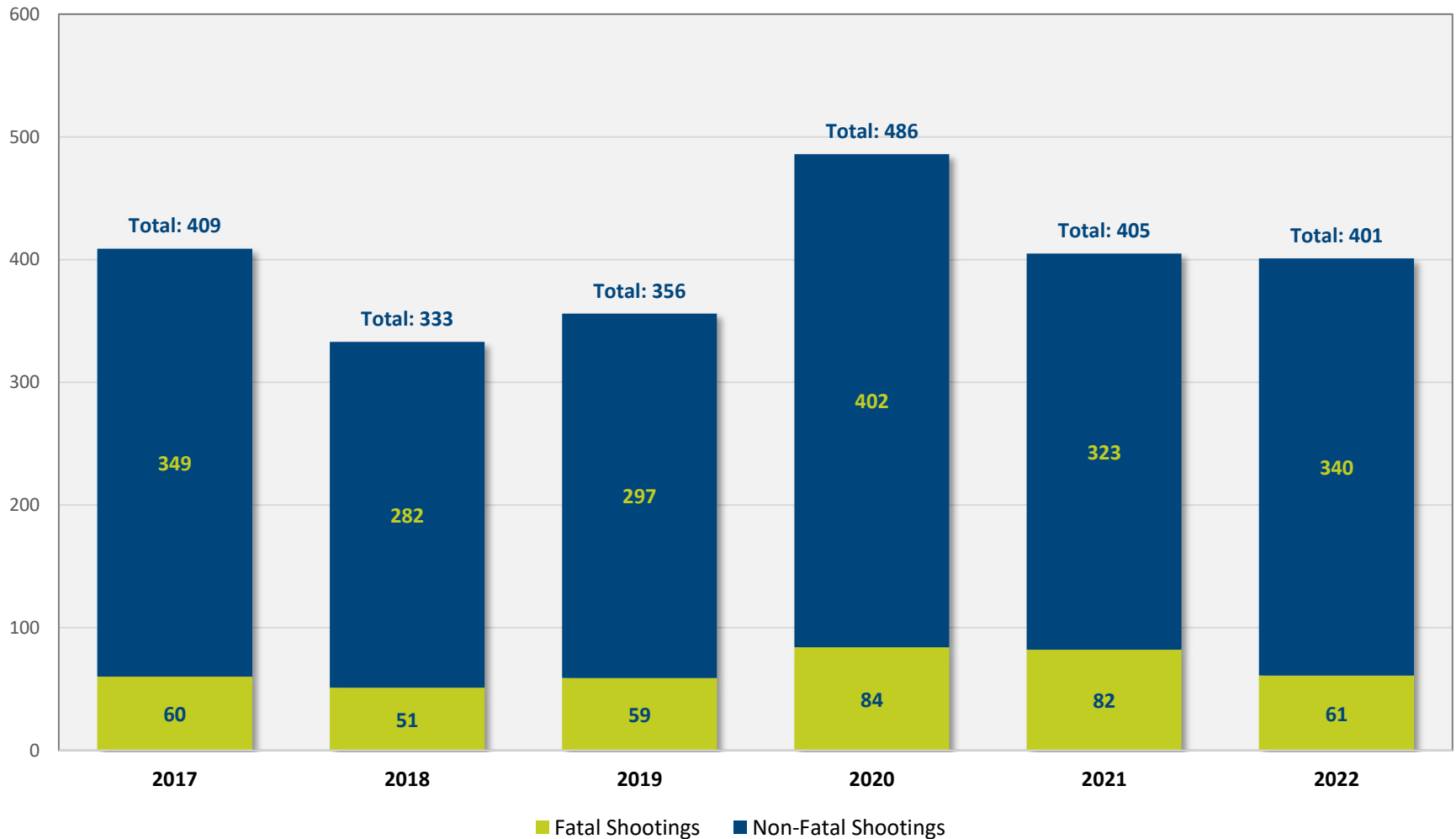

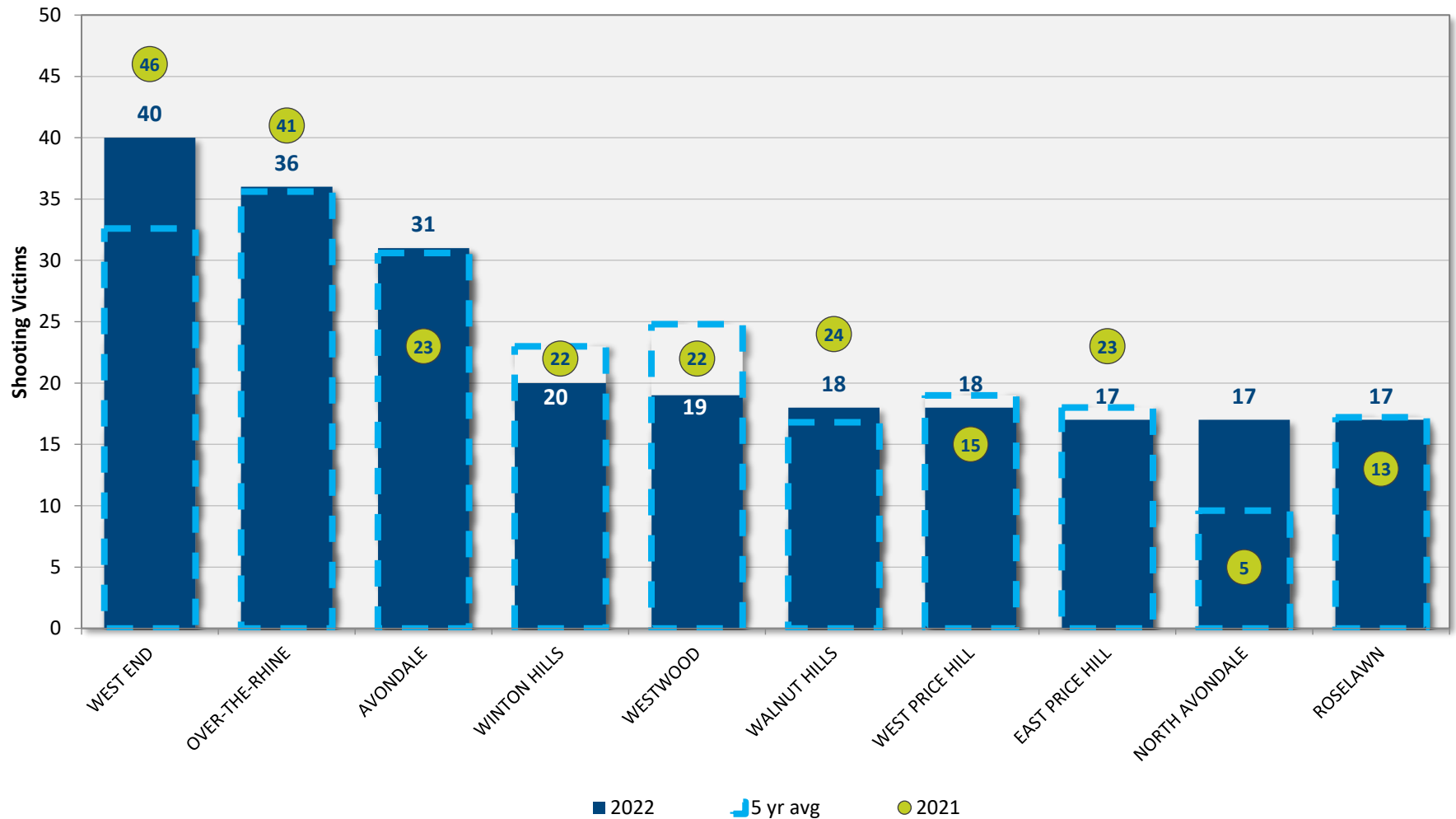

# Shooting Victims: Non-Fatal vs Fatal



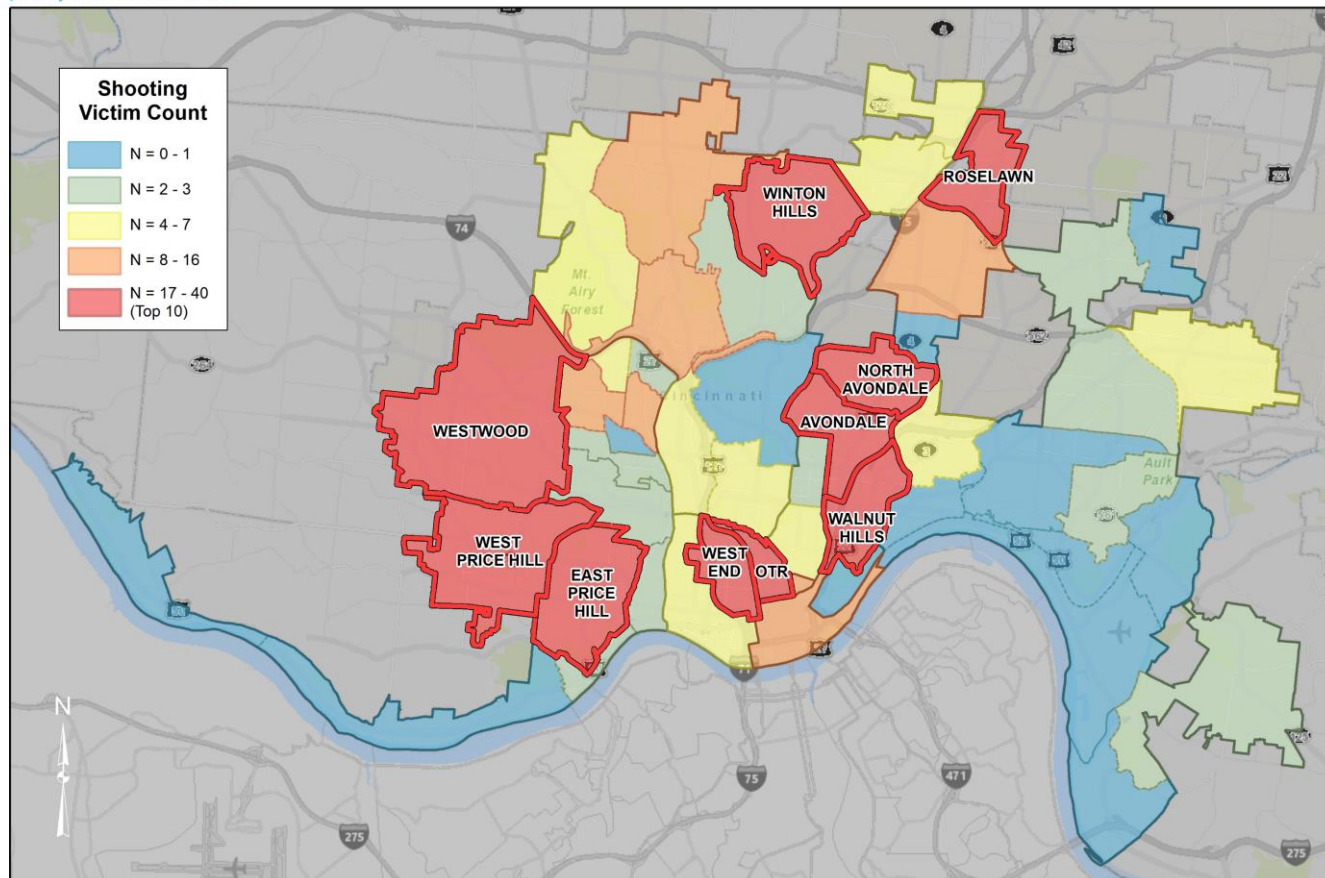

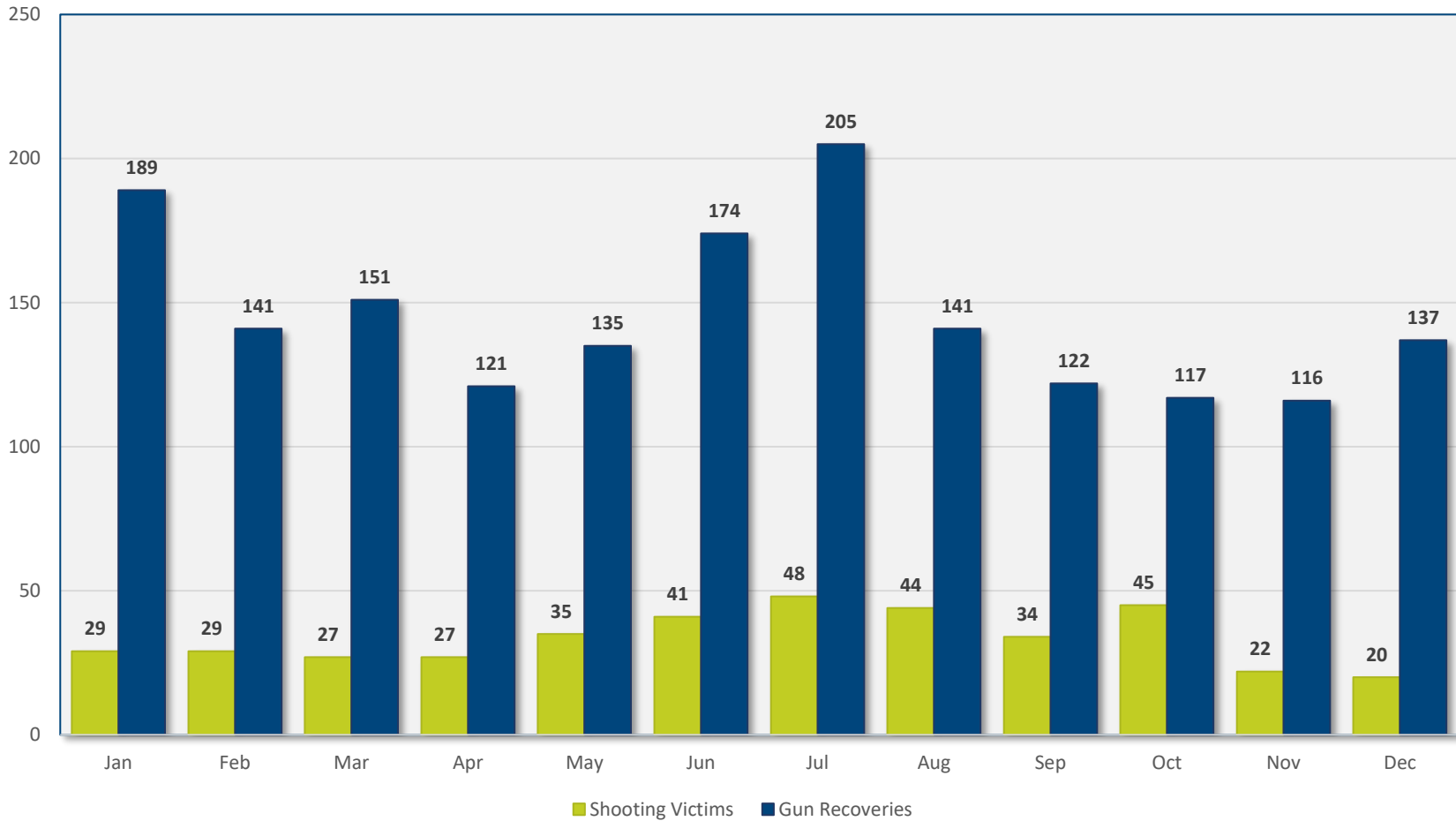

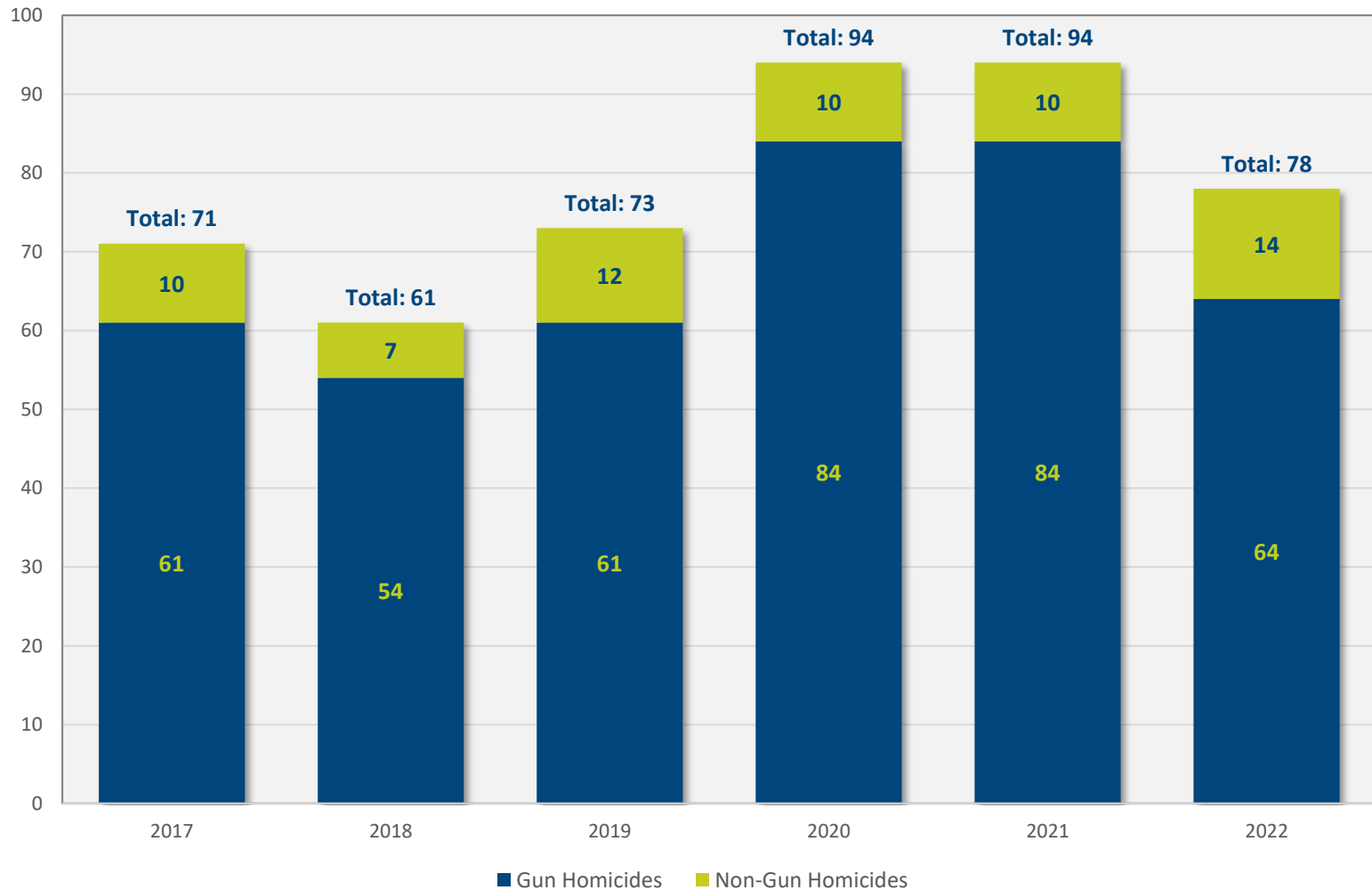

# Shootings vs. Gun Recoveries: Count by Month, 2022



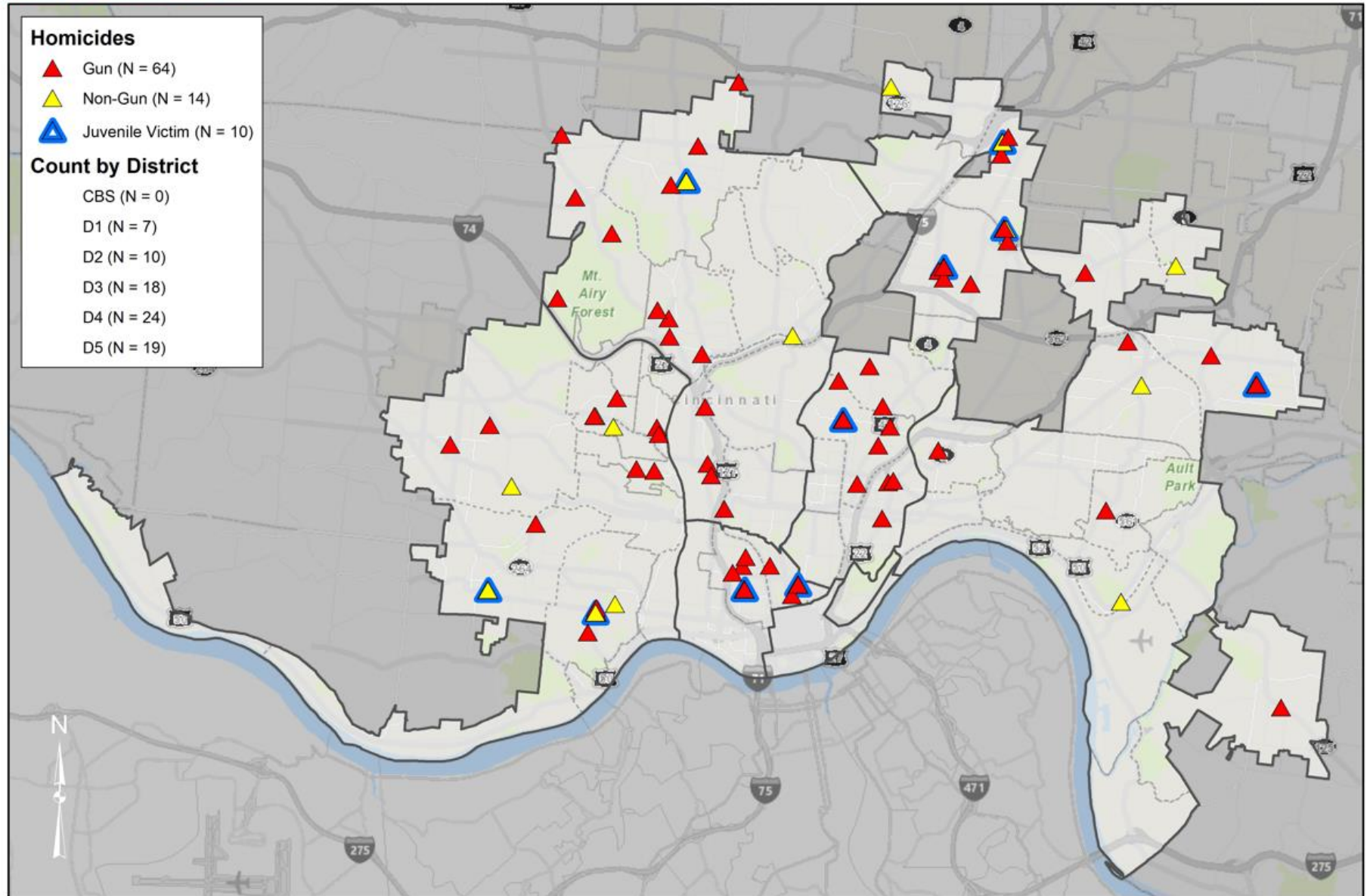


# Gun and Non-Gun Homicide Victims: 2017-2022

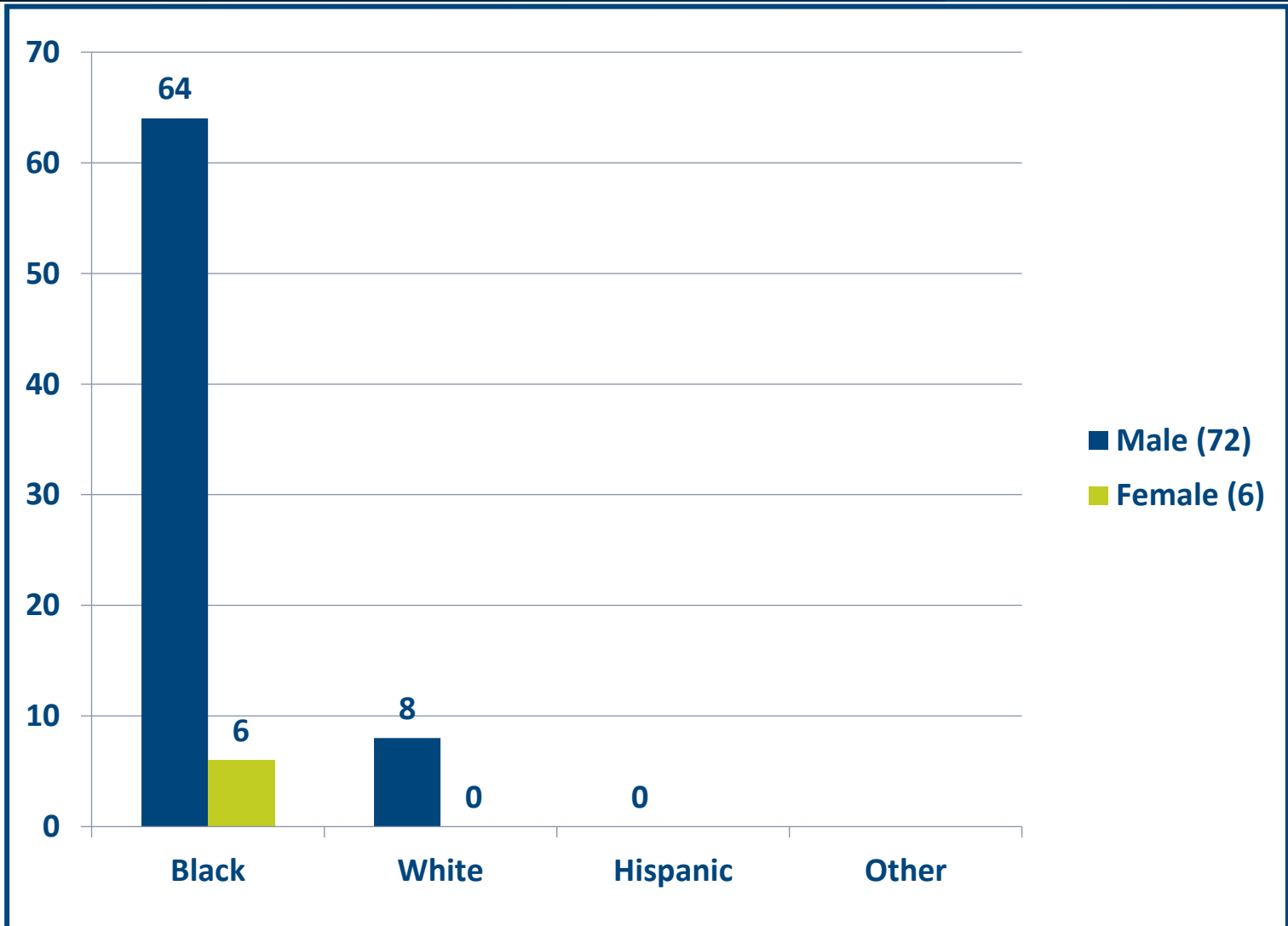

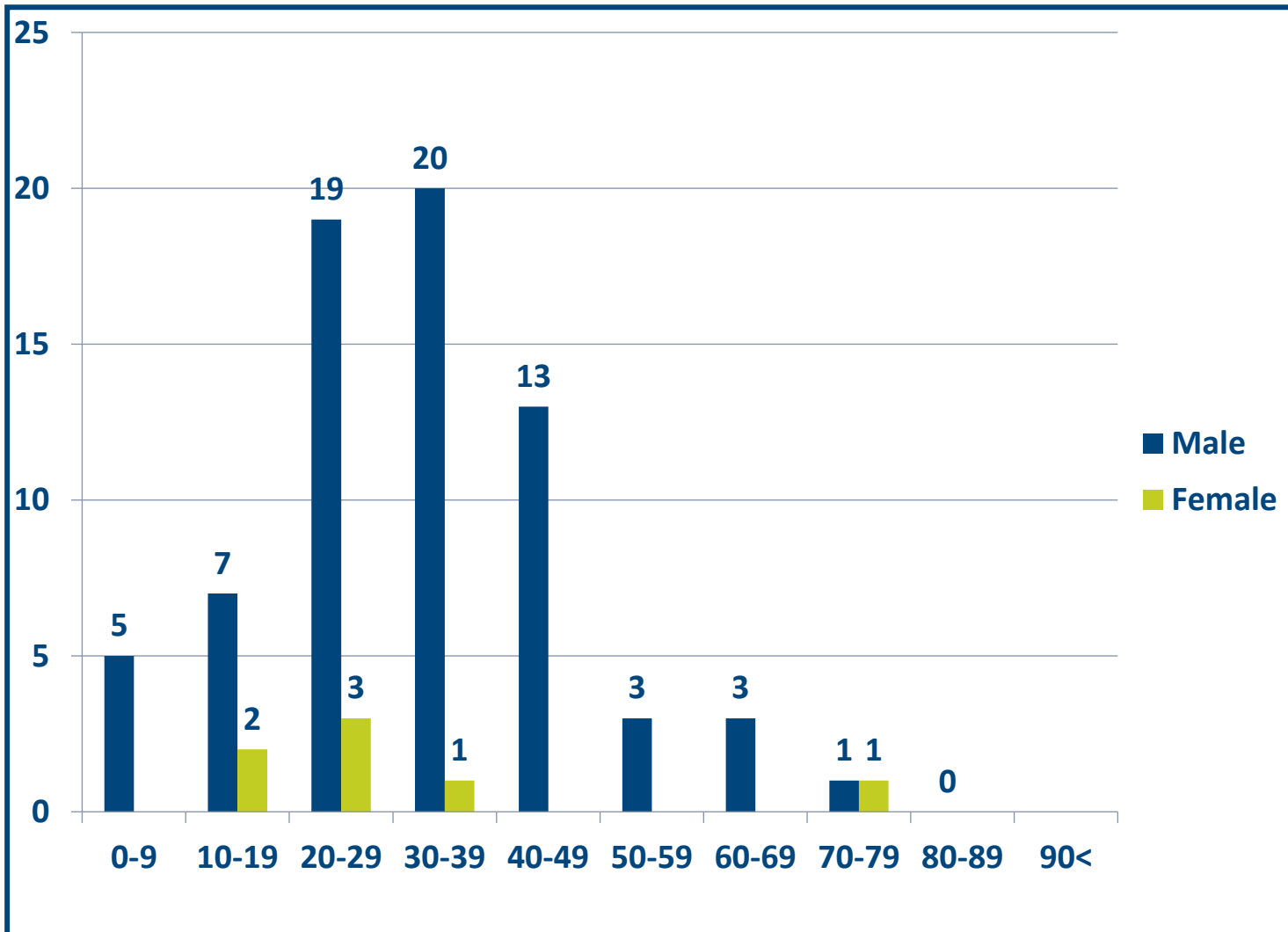

# Case Closures

- 2022 Closure Rate is 74% (2021 – 74%)
- A positive closure is considered:
  - Arrest
  - Death of Offender
  - Prosecution Declined
  - Suspect awaiting Grand Jury Presentation
  - National Clearance Rate 50%\*

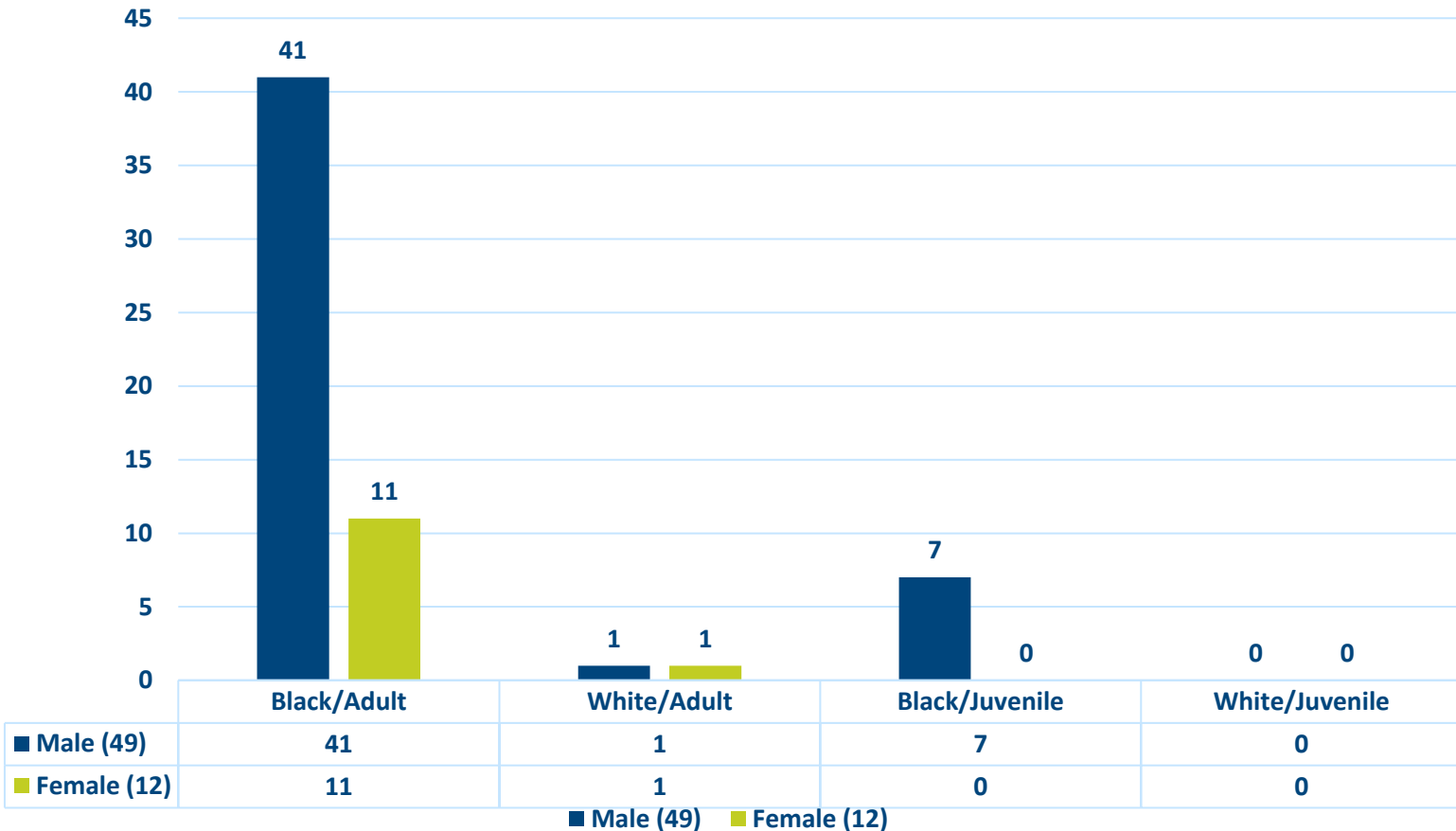
