Subject: Ordinance – Recreation: November 2021 Dick’s Sporting Goods Grant

Attached is an Ordinance captioned:

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount up to \$10,000 from the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation for the purpose of providing funding support to youth sports programs in need; and **AUTHORIZING** the Director of Finance to deposit the donated funds into Fund 319, “Contributions for Recreation Purposes.”

This Ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount of up to \$10,000 from the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation (CRF) for the purpose of providing funding support to youth sports programs in need. This Ordinance further authorizes the Director of Finance to deposit the donated funds into Fund 319, “Contributions for Recreation Purposes.”

CRF received a grant from Dick's Sporting Goods Foundation’s Sports Matter Community Grant Program to fund youth sports programs in the City. This grant will provide \$5,000 in resources for the Price Hill Community Center and \$5,000 for the Millvale Community Center.

There is no local match funding requirement, and there are no new FTEs associated with the grant.

This Ordinance is in accordance with the “Live” goal to “[c]reate a more livable community,” as described on page 156 of Plan Cincinnati (2012).

The Administration recommends passage of this Ordinance.
