

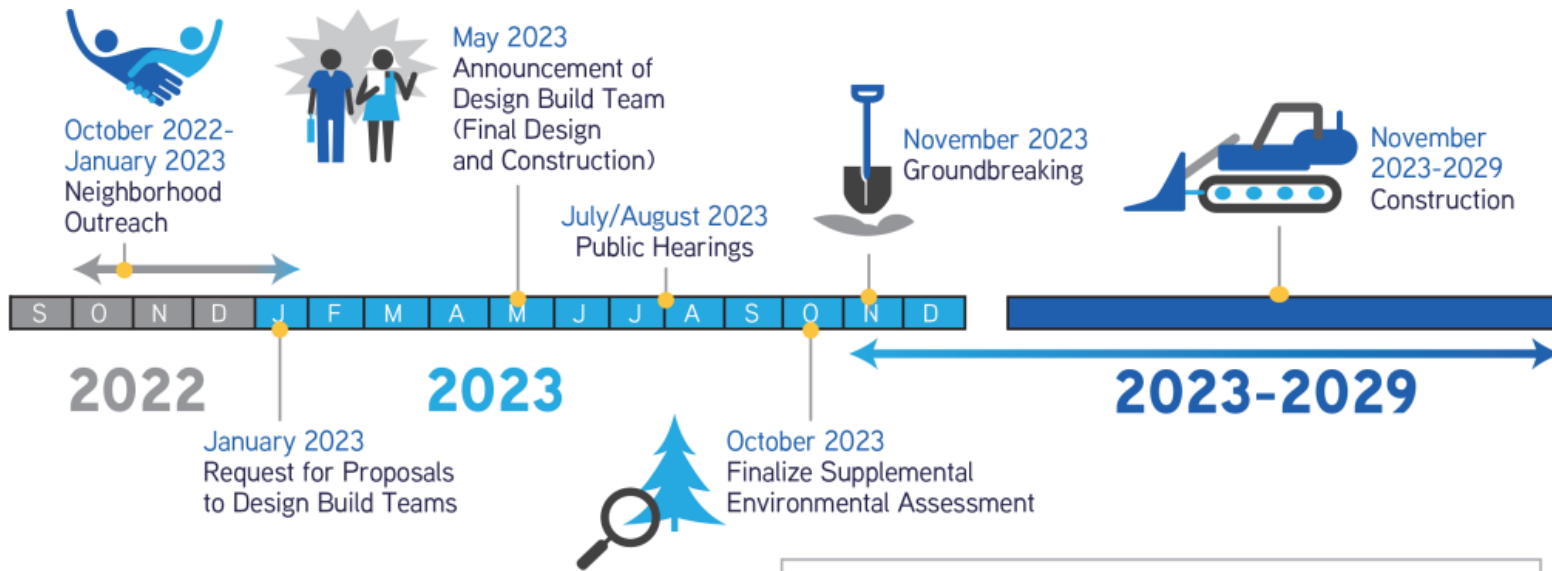

- Assist ODOT/KYTC in getting the project constructed

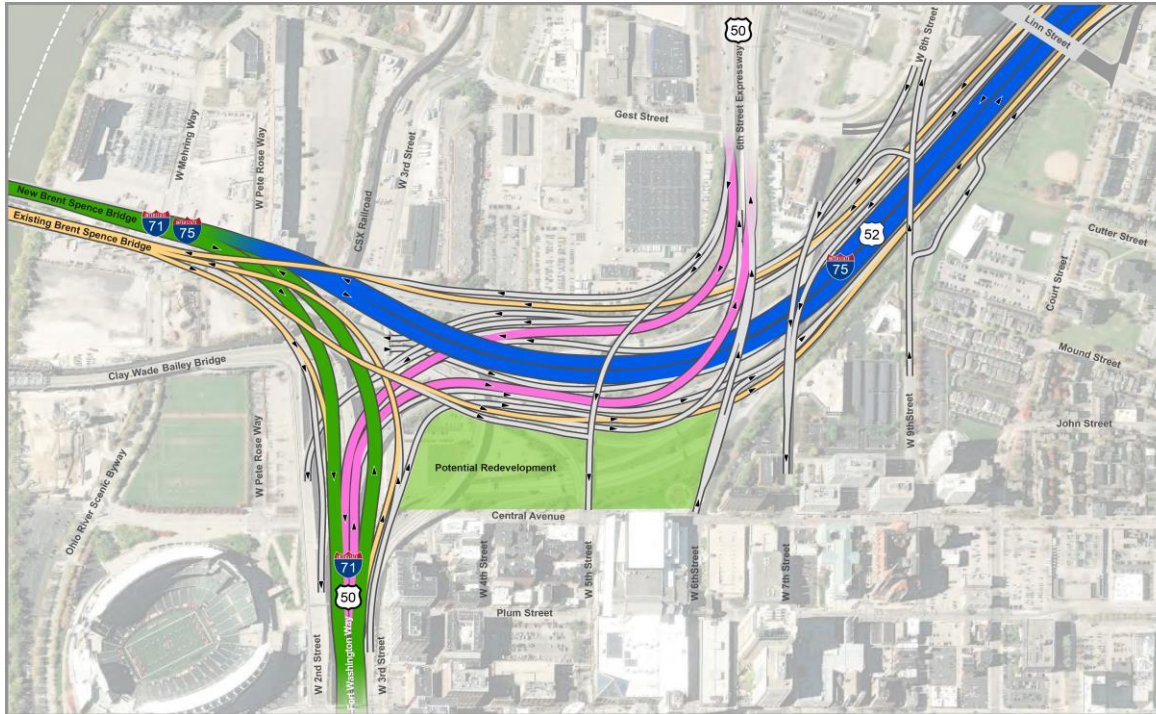


Right of way acquisition for this project began in June 2014 for ODOT and in May 2022 for KYTC and is expected to be complete by early 2024.

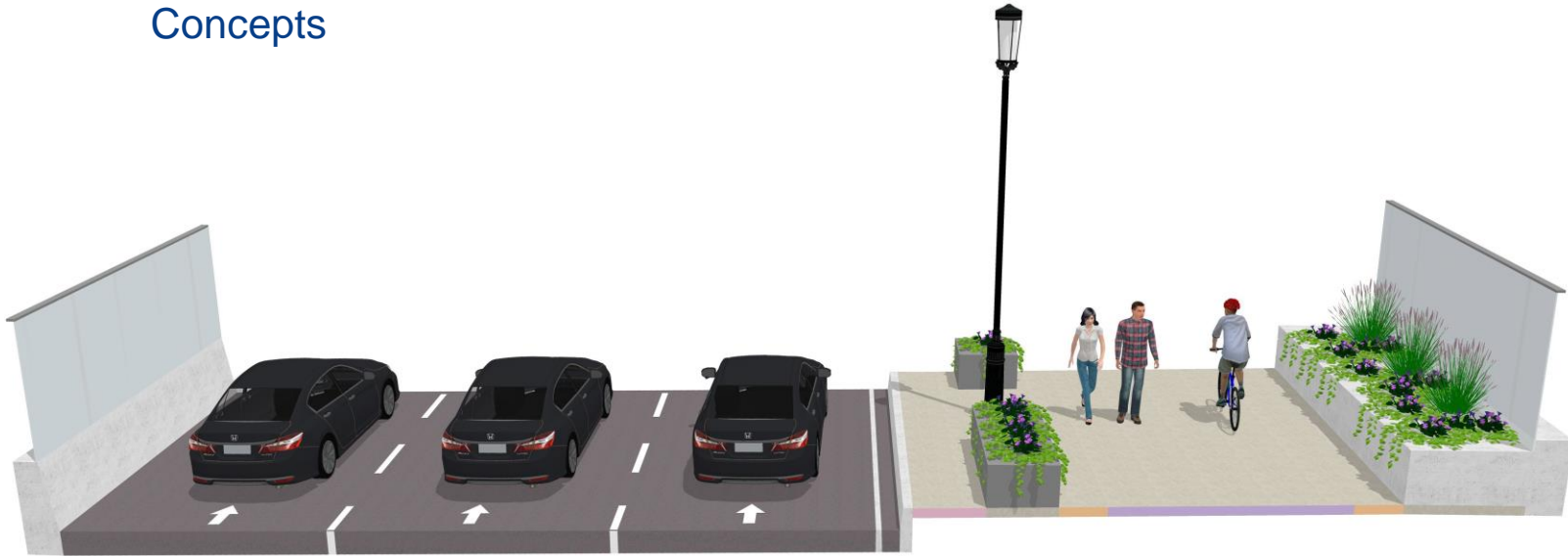

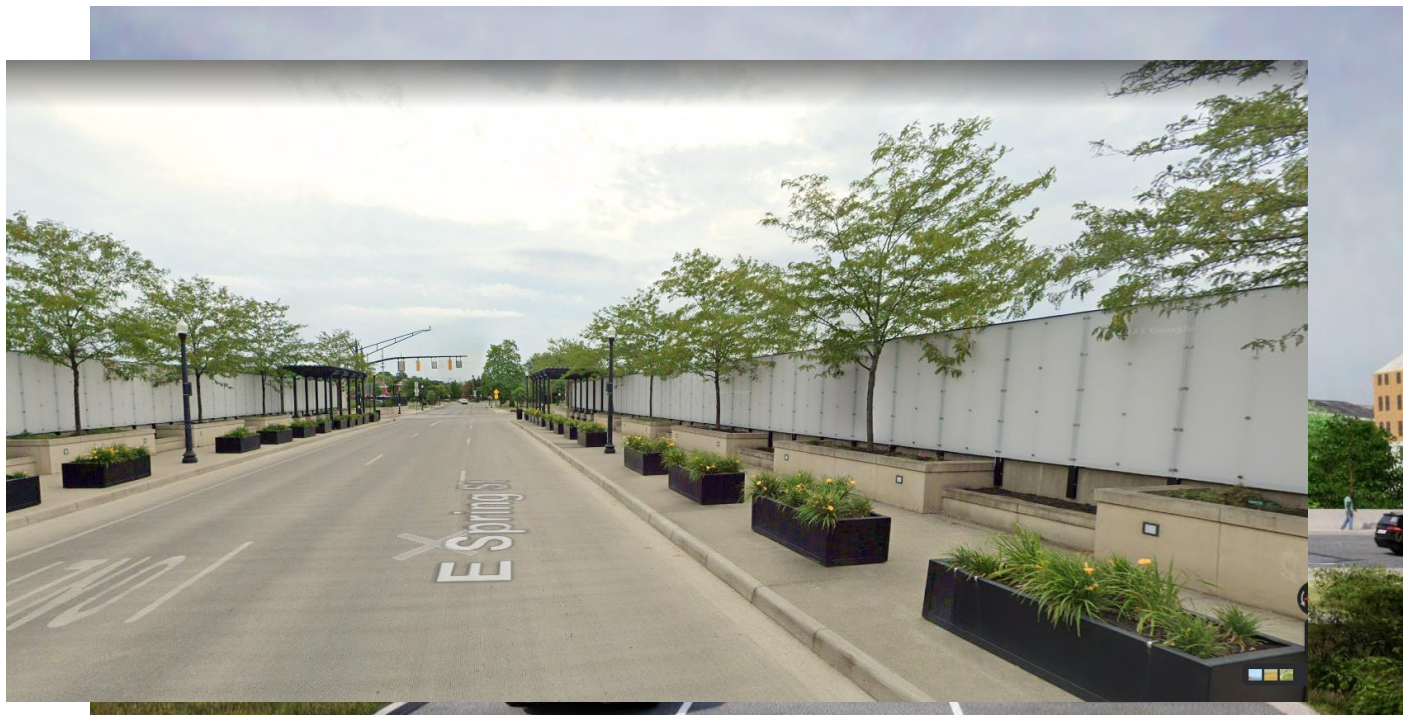

Interstate Access Changes in Downtown Cincinnati

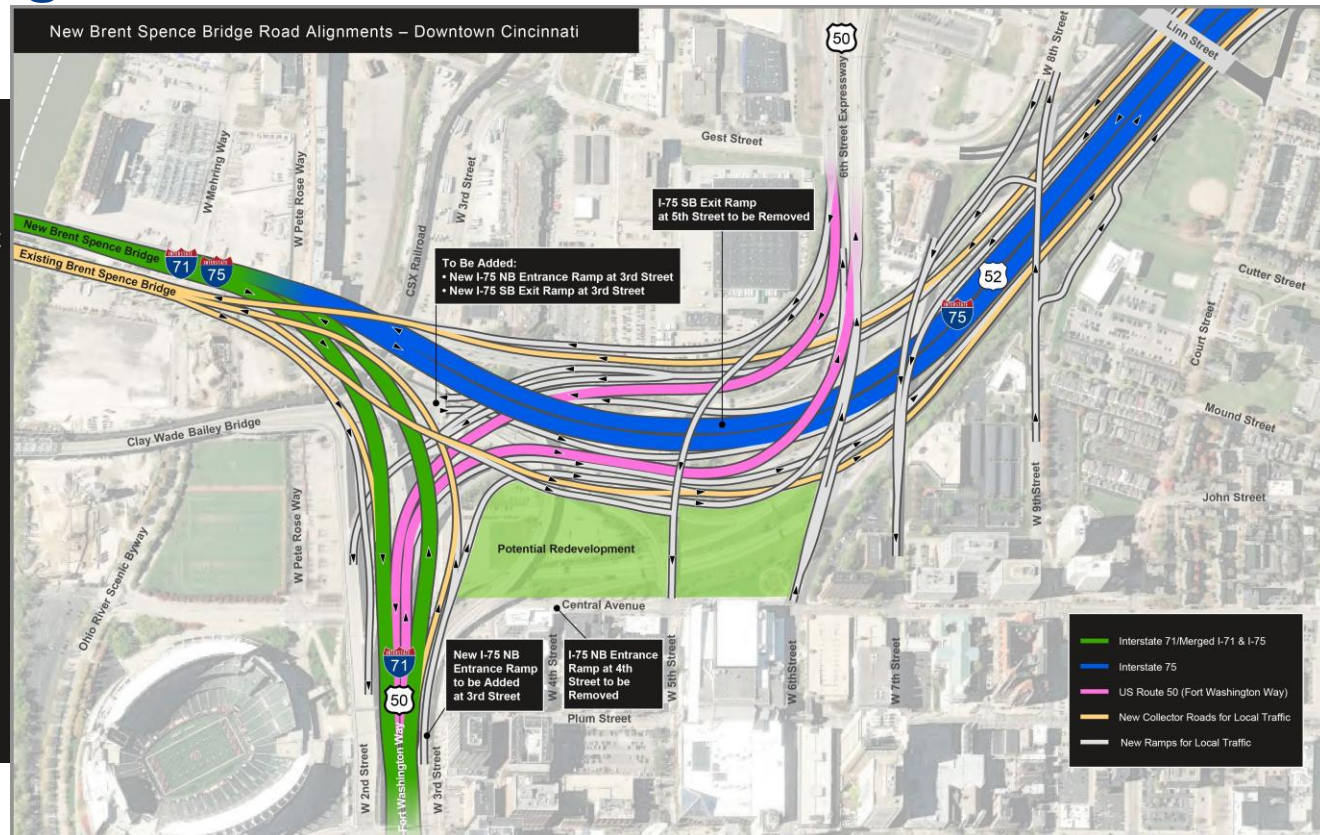
New entrance ramp to NB I-75 at 3rd Street east of Central Avenue

New entrance ramp to NB I-75 at the intersection of 3rd Street and the Clay Wade Bailey Bridge

New exit ramp from SB I-75 at the intersection of 3rd Street and the Clay Wade Bailey Bridge

Existing NB I-75 entrance ramp at 4th Street to be eliminated

Existing SB I-75 exit ramp at 5th Street to be eliminated



Next Steps

- Continue working with ODOY/KYTC through the Progressive Design-Build Process
 - Review the RFQ proposals and participate in consultant interviews
- DOTE has established a Brent Spence Bridge Advisory Committee made up of Community Council, Business and Regional representatives from the directly impacted neighborhoods.
 - DOTE will be able to quickly share information and obtain feedback throughout the project and provide ODOT/KYTC with clear responses as needed.
