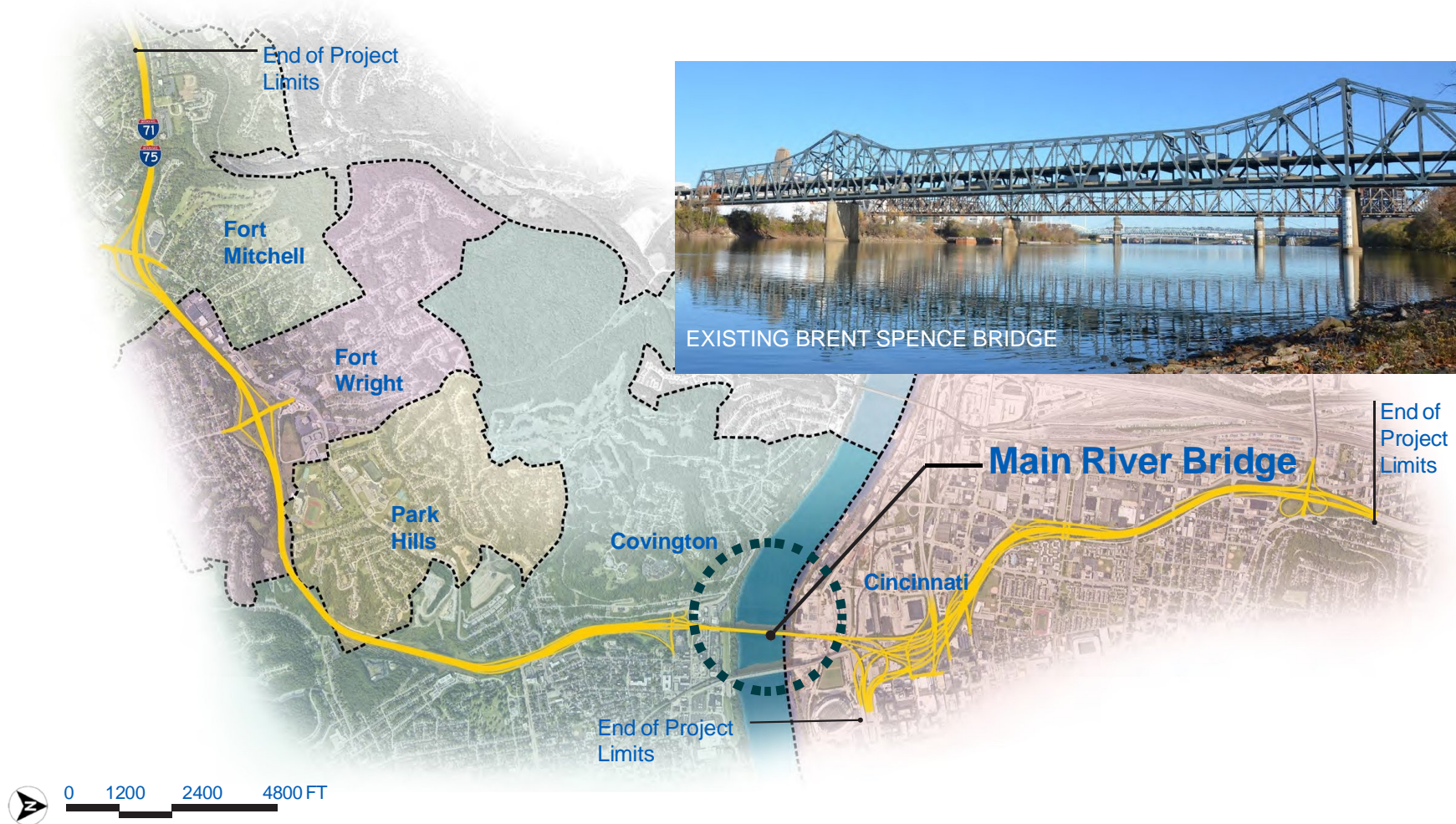
PROJECT OVERVIEW

KEY CONNECTIONS

- Improves safety and design
 - The Brent Spence bridge was restriped in 1985
- Addresses one of the worst truck bottlenecks in the nation
- Improves a critical highway network connecting Florida to Michigan
 - I-75 carries more than \$1B worth of freight every day
 - CVG is the 7th largest cargo airport in North America and the 20th in the world



BACKGROUND



RECENT ACTIVITIES (OCTOBER 2023-JUNE 2025)

- By the numbers
 - One million combined man-hours (WKJV + BSMT)
 - 300 Full Time Equivalent designers on the project
 - 52 subcontractors, including 31 design firms
 - 309,000 cubic yards of structural concrete
 - 95M pounds of structural steel (5 x Paycor Stadium)
- Both OH and KY have continuously collaborated with local representatives regarding design elements of the project



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Schedule of work is being developed now
- Design will be 60% complete this fall
- Early work in 2025; in-water work expected to begin in 2026
