**Subject:** **Ordinance – Cincinnati Recreation Commission (CRC): Corbeau Ski Club In-Kind Donation**

Attached is an Ordinance captioned:

**AUTHORIZING** the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation of goods and professional services from Corbeau Ski Club, through the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation, valued at approximately \$63,000 to support the Cincinnati Recreation Commission's Learn to Ski/Snowboard program, in which all Cincinnati youth can participate.

Approval of this Ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation from Corbeau Ski Club, through the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation, valued at approximately \$63,000 to support the Cincinnati Recreation Commission's Learn to Ski/Snowboard program open to Cincinnati youth.

CRC's Learn to Ski/Snowboard program provides underserved youth, between the ages of ten and seventeen, with an opportunity to spend six weeks learning to ski and snowboard. Participants are exposed to new experiences while developing confidence and independence. Corbeau Ski Club invited CRC's Learn to Ski/Snowboard program to utilize lift passes and equipment rentals at Perfect North Slopes and offered to provide ski and snowboard instruction through the 2025-2026 winter season.

This in-kind donation does not require matching funds or new FTEs/full time equivalents.

Enabling young Cincinnatians to learn to ski and snowboard is in accordance with the "Live" goal to "[w]ork in synergy with the Cincinnati community" and strategy to "[b]uild a robust life" as described on page 149 of Plan Cincinnati (2012).

The Administration recommends passage of this Ordinance.
