Voice:

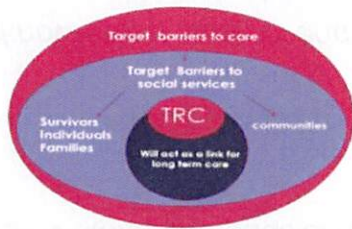
Our services ensure that victims are not alone. We give victims a voice to help them be in control of their future.
