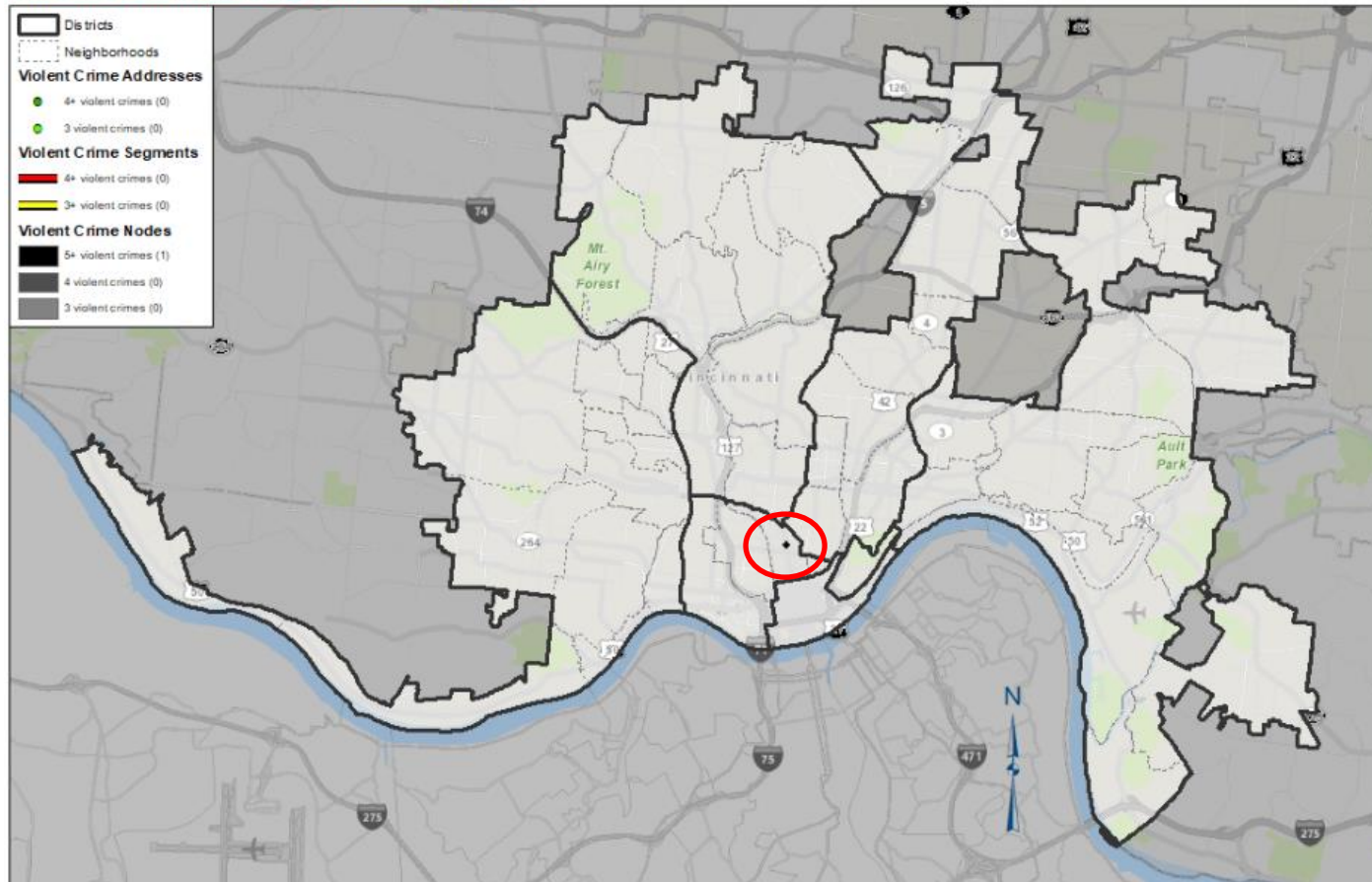

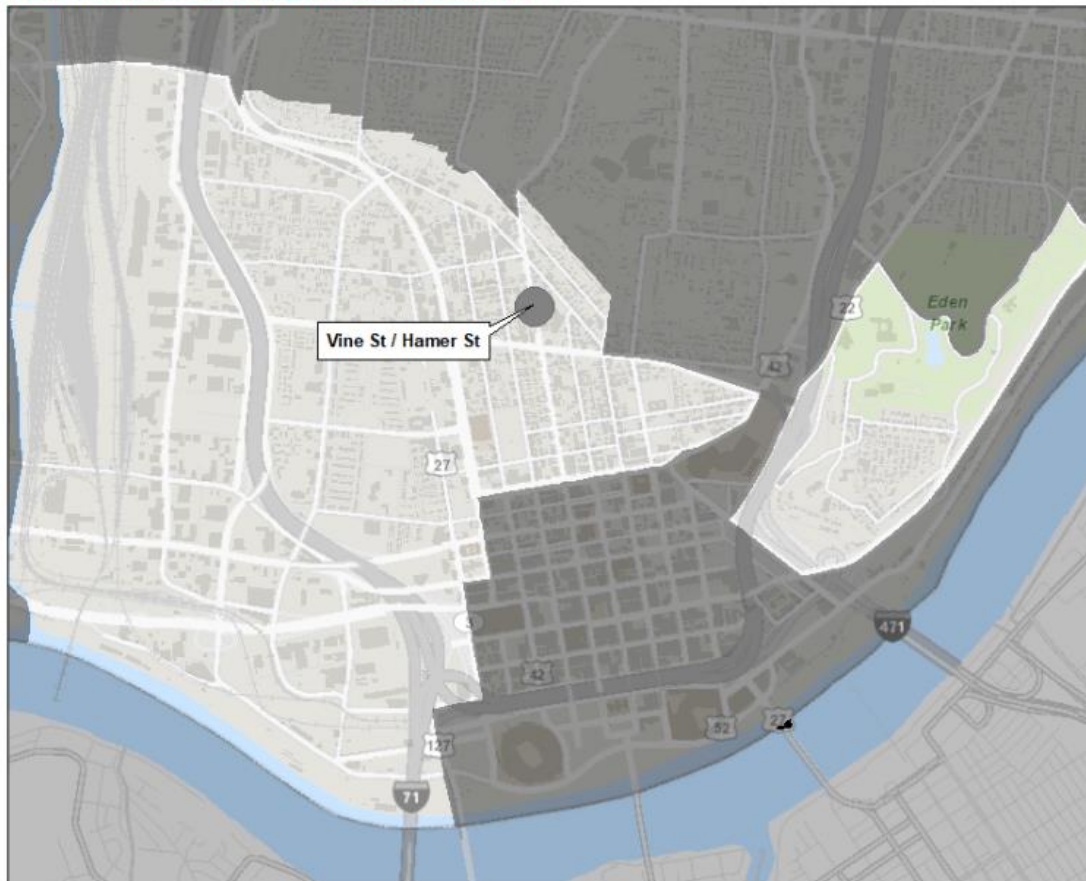

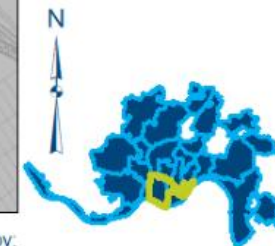

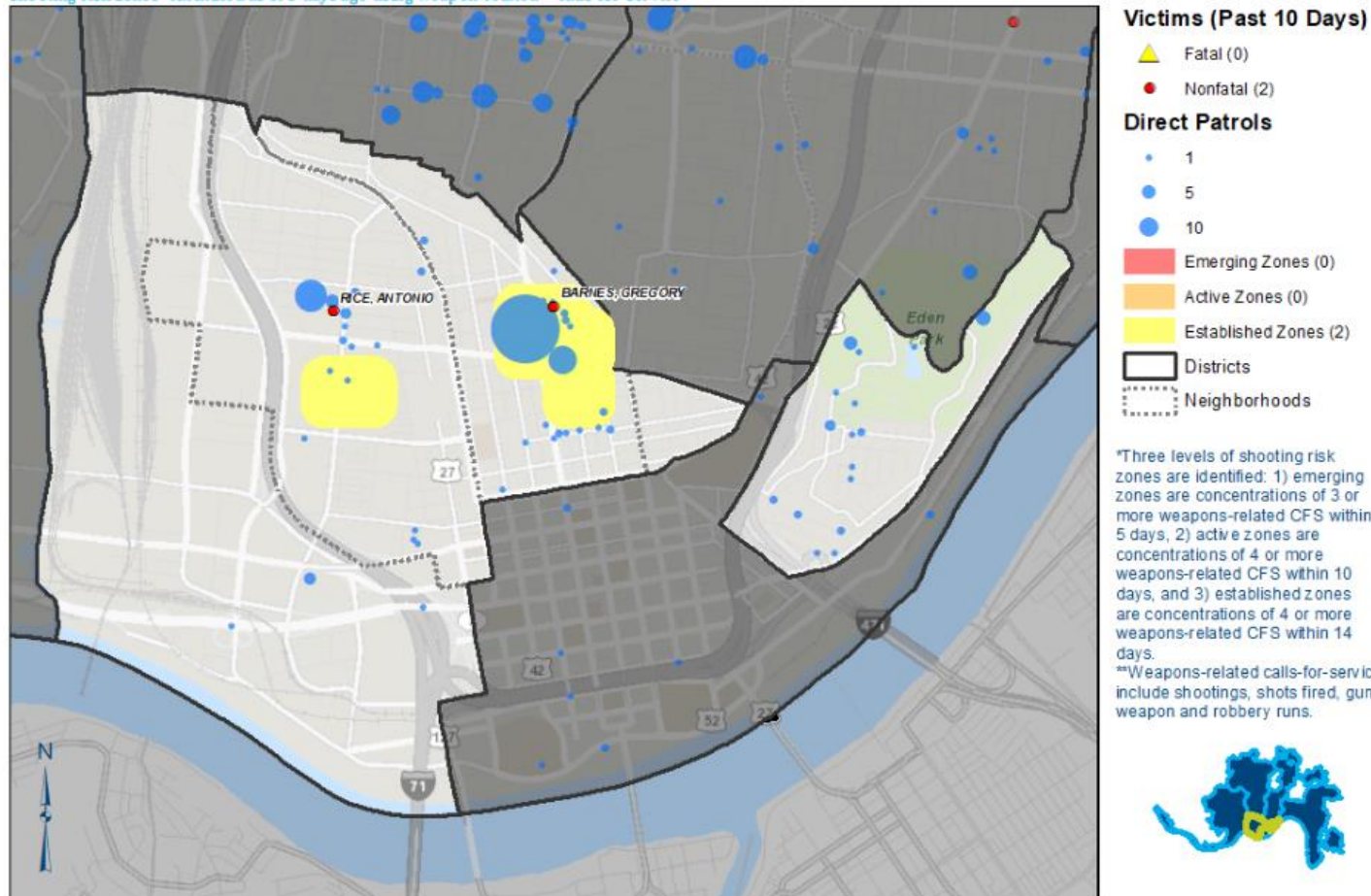

# Response – Directed Patrol

## Directed Patrols and Elevated Shooting Risk Areas past 10 days ending 07-Jan-21: District 1



Shooting risk zones\* identified as of 5 days ago using weapon-related\*\* calls-for-service



\*Three levels of shooting risk zones are identified: 1) emerging zones are concentrations of 3 or more weapons-related CFS within 5 days, 2) active zones are concentrations of 4 or more weapons-related CFS within 10 days, and 3) established zones are concentrations of 4 or more weapons-related CFS within 14 days.

\*\*Weapons-related calls-for-service include shootings, shots fired, gun, weapon and robbery runs.

District One was allotted \$30,000 of PVO overtime funds to be utilized between the months of October 2020 through December 2020. The District One PVO plan is detailed below:

## Overview

District One analyzed violent crime data (Felonious Assaults, Shootings, Homicides, Rapes and Robberies) from January 1, 2020 to October 9, 2020. The following locations were identified as problem areas where PVO should be directed:

### OTR Violent Crime locations:

- > Green & Republic Streets
- > Grant Park – McMicken Ave., Back & Hamer Streets
- > 1600 Walnut Street and north to Moore Street
- > 1200 Main Street north to Liberty Street

The attached density maps demonstrate the historical violence associated with these street segments for 2020. Day of the week and hour of day data supports the hours of deployment in four-hour blocks that span 2000 to 0300 hours.

### West End Violent Crime location:

- > Linn & Poplar Streets
- > Linn & Livingston Streets
- > Baymiller & Findlay Streets
  - > Laurel Park Drive, John & David Streets have become prime areas of gunfire as confirmed by ShotSpotter activations.

By focusing PVO activity in these areas in addition to VCS investigations, the deployment of light towers, restricted parking hours and Resident Permit Parking we can begin to mitigate some of the violence.

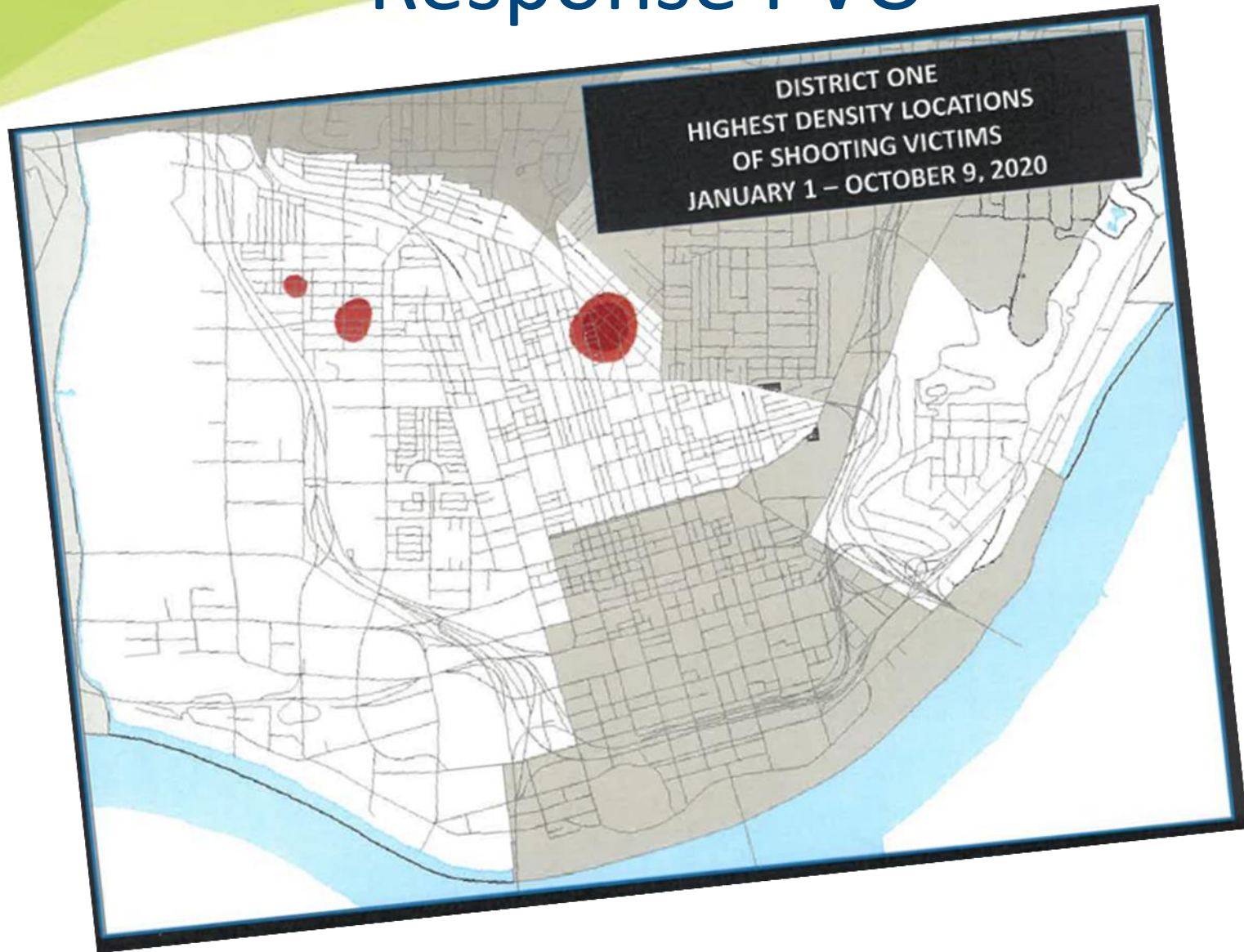

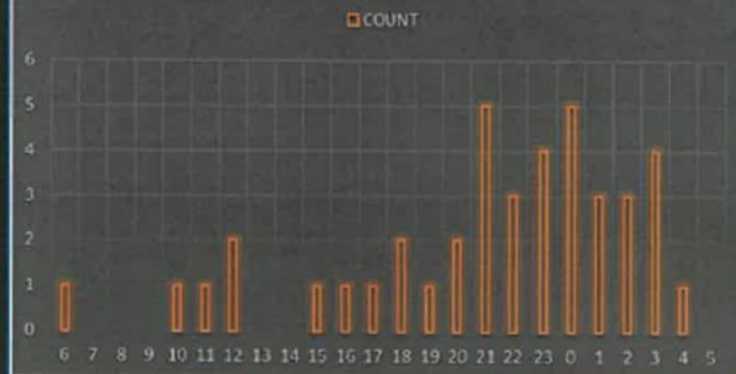
