ESTABLISHING new capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, “Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements,” for the purpose of improving pedestrian and bicycle safety in the Victory Parkway Corridor between Martin Drive and McMillan Avenue, improving the condition and safety of the Park Avenue Bridge over Kemper Lane, and installing a sidewalk along the west side of Eden Park Drive from St. Paul Drive to Krohn Conservatory; **AUTHORIZING** the City Manager to accept and appropriate a federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (ALN 20.205) in an amount up to \$6,000,000, awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, to new capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, “Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements”; **AUTHORIZING** the Director of Finance to deposit the grant resources into newly established capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, “Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements,” for the purpose of improving pedestrian and bicycle safety in the Victory Parkway Corridor between Martin Drive and McMillan Avenue, improving the condition and safety of the Park Avenue Bridge over Kemper Lane, and installing a sidewalk along the west side of Eden Park Drive from St. Paul Drive to Krohn Conservatory; and **AUTHORIZING** the City Manager to execute any agreements necessary for the receipt and administration of these grant resources.

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2021, Council approved Ordinance No. 0205-2021, which authorized the City Manager to apply for up to \$6,000,000 from the federal Surface Transportation Block Grant, awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, for the purpose of completing several transportation projects managed by the City’s Department of Transportation & Engineering; and

WHEREAS, these grant resources require local matching resources of up to 34 percent, which will be covered by a combination of capital improvement program project accounts, future Ohio Public Works Commission funding, and other available resources; and

WHEREAS, no new FTEs are associated with this grant; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation and improvement of the City’s transportation infrastructure is in accordance with the “Connect” goal to “[d]evelop an efficient multi-modal transportation system that supports neighborhood livability,” as well as the strategy to “[p]lan, design and implement a safe and sustainable transportation system,” described on pages 129-138 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to establish new capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, “Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements,” for the purpose of improving pedestrian and bicycle safety in the Victory Parkway

Corridor between Martin Drive and McMillan Avenue, improving the condition and safety of the Park Avenue Bridge over Kemper Lane, and installing a sidewalk along the west side of Eden Park Drive from St. Paul Drive to Krohn Conservatory.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate grant resources up to \$6,000,000 from a federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (ALN 20.205), awarded by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, to new capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, "Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements."

Section 3. That the Director of Finance is authorized to deposit the grant resources into newly established capital improvement program project account no. 980x232x222359, "Victory Pkwy – Eden Park Safety Improvements," for the purpose of improving pedestrian and bicycle safety in the Victory Parkway Corridor between Martin Drive and McMillan Avenue, improving the condition and safety of the Park Avenue Bridge over Kemper Lane, and installing a sidewalk along the west side of Eden Park Drive from St. Paul Drive to Krohn Conservatory.

Section 4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any agreements necessary for the receipt and administration of these grant resources.

Section 5. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to comply with the terms of this grant and Sections 1 through 4 hereof.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
