- Findlay Playground new recreation facility along Vine Street; maintain some portion of existing green space for outdoor programming
- Grant Park renovate for outdoor activities
- Elm St Playground renovate for outdoor activities
- Existing OTR Rec Center renovate for partner programming









Findlay Playground Recommendations

- Findlay Playground was recommended as the site for a new community center
- The site can accommodate large programmatic elements like a gym and indoor aquatics
- Outdoor programming located at Grant Park near community center
- The existing OTR Rec Center can potentially remain in operation during a portion of construction
