RESOLUTION NO. 6 - 2026

RECOGNIZING Ryan Mooney-Bullock and **EXPRESSING** the appreciation of the Mayor and the Council of the City of Cincinnati for Ms. Mooney-Bullock's service as Executive Director of Green Umbrella, Greater Cincinnati's Region Climate Collaborative, and the amount of work she has undertaken personally and professionally to make Greater Cincinnati more climate driven.

WHEREAS, Ryan Mooney-Bullock has spent the last 26 years working in science, environmental education, and environmental policy, and over the last 8.5 years she has served as the Executive Director of Green Umbrella; and

WHEREAS, during Ms. Mooney-Bullock's tenure as Executive Director, Green Umbrella's staff quadrupled and launched eight new programs; worked with Cincinnati Public Schools to initiate sixty new green schoolyards; cultivated Tri-State Trails from a program to a nonprofit and raised over \$50,000,000 for regional trails; planted 41 orchards, producing around 13,600 pounds of fruit; completed 21 neighborhood resilience plans in collaboration with Groundwork Ohio River Valley; and Green Umbrella moved from a Regional Sustainability Alliance to a Region Climate Collaborative; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mooney-Bullock oversaw the Midwest Regional Sustainability Summit, which has seen its attendance double, and fostered a network of over 55 talented staff and intern alumni who are now making an impact across the region and country in a variety of fields; and

WHEREAS, Green Umbrella now enters a new phase as an organization because of the leadership and determination of Ms. Mooney-Bullock's tenure, and aims to continue to bring climate action across our region that is equitable and collaborative, centers community voice, and build interconnected and resilient communities; and

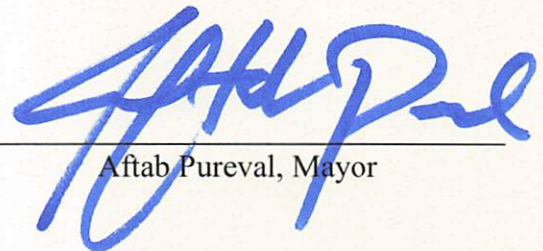
WHEREAS, Ms. Mooney-Bullock is now beginning a new chapter in her professional life by moving to Gorman Heritage Farm in Evendale, where she will help steward a 122-acre legacy farm and its community of plants, animals, staff, volunteers, and visitors; now, therefore,
