


Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is in response to your August 13, 2024 correspondence to the Clerk of Council pertaining to a proposed charter amendment petition. In its current form, the proposed charter amendment petition does not comply with necessary form requirements set forth in the Charter of the City of Cincinnati ("Charter").

Per the Charter, Article II, Section 8(A)(1), petitions must comply with the specified form and general laws of the state. The proposed petition does not include a title of the proposal, which must clearly and without argument describe the proposed charter amendment and appear at the top of each part petition. Charter, Article II, Section 8(A)(1)(d). The proposed charter amendment petition also does not bear the names of at least five qualified electors of the City to serve as the petition committee, as required by Article II, Section 8(A)(2) of the Charter. Finally, the proposed charter amendment petition is not a certified petition, required by Charter, Article II, Section 8(A)(3), as the proposed petition lacks an attached certification.
