RESOLUTION NO. 109 - 2025

EESW

ADOPTING the Calendar Year Budget for Current Operating Expenses of the City for calendar year 2027 and **SUBMITTING** the same to the County Auditor.

WHEREAS, a tentative Calendar Year Budget of Current Operating Expenses of the City has been prepared for calendar year 2027 ("Budget") showing detailed estimates of all balances that will be available at the beginning of calendar year 2027 for the purposes of such calendar year and of all revenues to be received for such calendar year including all general and special taxes, fees, costs, percentages, penalties, allowances, prerequisites, and all other types and classes of revenue; estimates of all expenditures or changes in or for the purposes of such calendar year to be paid or met from such revenues and balances; and otherwise conforming to the requirements of the charter and ordinances of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Budget will be made conveniently available for public inspection for at least ten days by having at least two copies on file in the offices of the Director of Finance and the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, Council will set a public hearing as to the Budget, public notice of which will be given by publication not less than ten days prior to the date of the hearing; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the submitted Calendar Year Budget of Current Operating Expenses, copies of which have been and are on file in the offices of the Director of Finance and the Clerk of Council, that provides 6.1 mills for the operating property tax for calendar year 2027 and 7.5 mills to cover current outstanding debt service and the planned fiscal year 2027 General Capital Budget is adopted as the official Calendar Year Budget of Current Operating Expenses of the City for calendar year 2027 ("Budget").

Section 2. That the Clerk is authorized and directed to certify a copy of the Budget and a copy of this resolution and to transmit the same to the Auditor of Hamilton County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this legislative resolution shall be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare, and shall, subject to the terms of Article II, Section 6 of the Charter, be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to ensure that the Budget is adopted by the time required by law.
