WHEREAS, Ms. Fraley and Ms. Johnson encountered the victim while on their way to class and immediately jumped into action, applying pressure to the victim's wounds and keeping him conscious until EMTs could arrive; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Fraley and Ms. Johnson were prepared to react quickly and effectively due to in-school education, certification programs, and internships provided by Woodward Career Technical High School; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Fraley and Ms. Johnson serve as role models for young people as well as the community at large; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:
