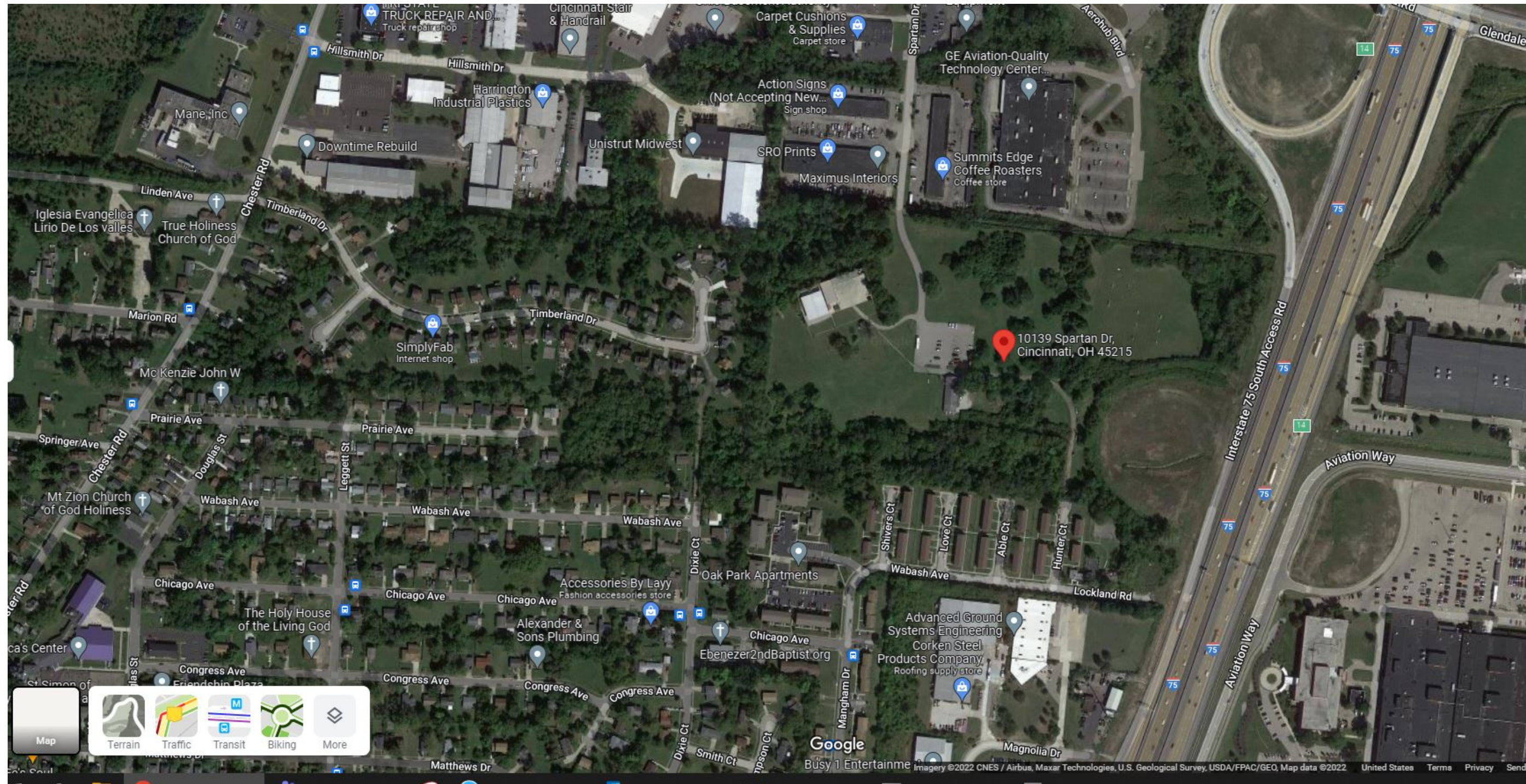

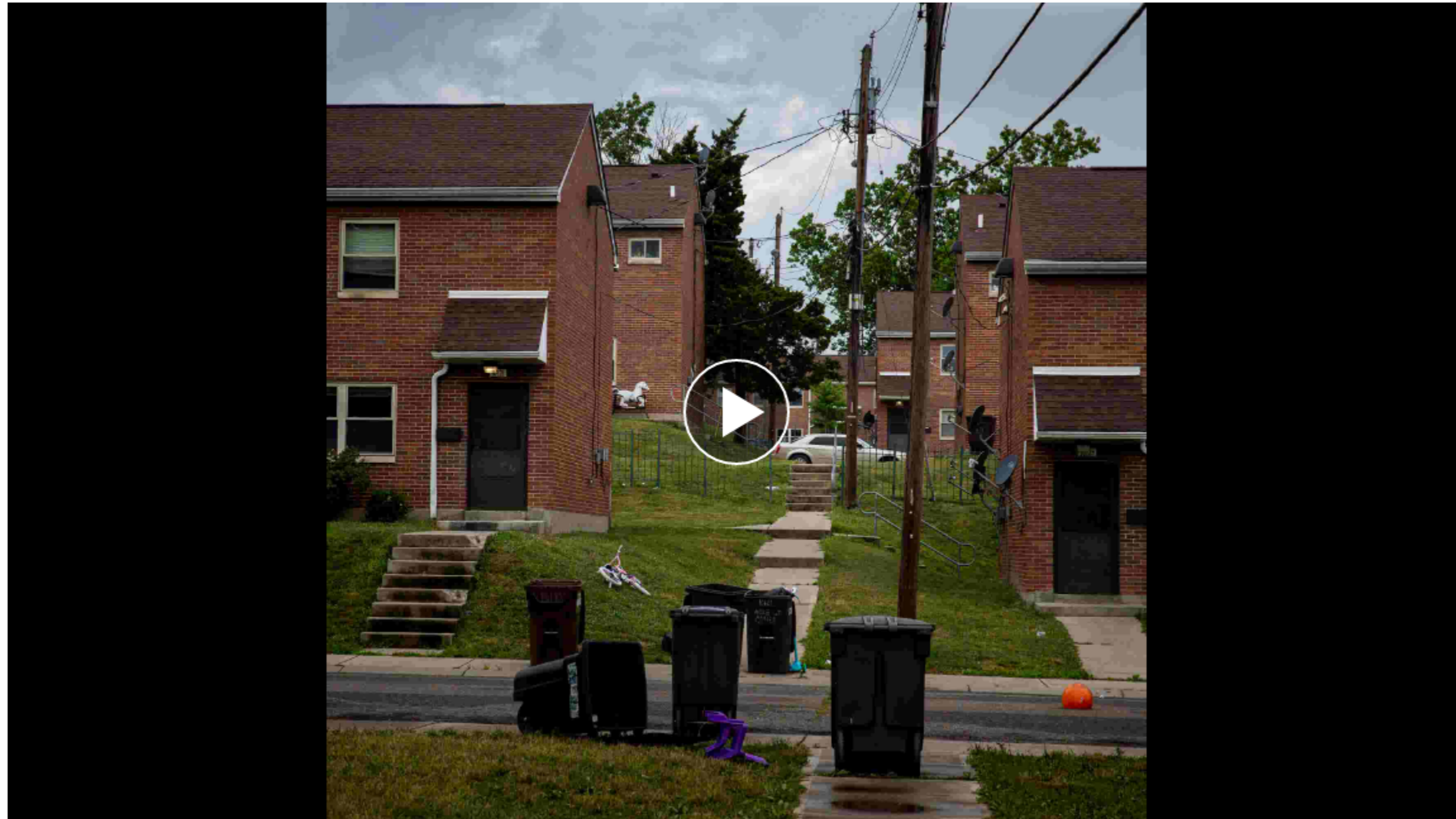

\$27M - \$42M

 - Inclusion of Skid Pad
 - Inclusion of K-9 Training Area
 - Utilities
