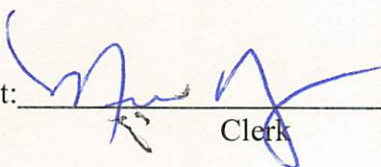
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

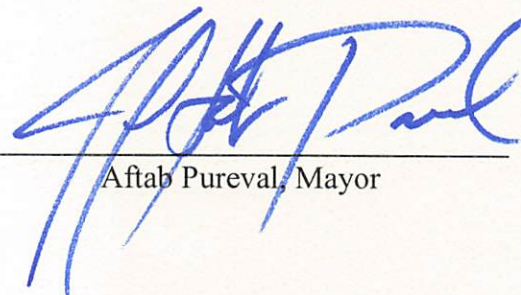
