

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept in-kind donations and contributions of miscellaneous supplies from the Cincinnati Parks Foundation, valued at approximately \$188,292.89, to benefit various City parks.

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Parks Foundation (“Foundation”) has provided miscellaneous supplies and services from and through various businesses as in-kind donations to the City of Cincinnati to benefit and improve various City parks; and

WHEREAS, the total value of the in-kind donations is approximately \$188,292.89; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation provided a donation valued at approximately \$6,465 from Decal Impressions for the new metal butterfly at Krohn Conservatory; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation provided a donation valued at approximately \$7,400.47 from Kendrick & O’Dell to support landscape maintenance at Liberty Gardens; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation provided a donation valued at approximately \$17,500 from Applied Imagination for the new City Hall model for the Holiday show at Krohn Conservatory; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation provided a donation valued at approximately \$25,000 from Iron Belle Metal Design, LLC to provide a large commemorative metal butterfly for Krohn Conservatory; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation provided a donation valued at approximately \$131,927.42 from Neil Bortz and Towne Properties to support the design of the Eden Parks Steps at the Playhouse in the Park; and

WHEREAS, these donations and contributions fall outside the parameters established in Ordinance No. 62-2024 and require discrete approval; and

WHEREAS, these donations require no matching funds, and there are no new FTEs/full time equivalents associated with these donations; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of in-kind donations and contributions to benefit various City parks is in accordance with the “Sustain” goal to “[p]reserve our natural and built environment” as described on page 193 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept in-kind donations and contributions of miscellaneous supplies and services from the Cincinnati Parks Foundation, valued at approximately \$188,292.89, to benefit various City parks.

Section 2. That the proper City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the terms of Section 1.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
