

RESOLUTION NO. 13 - 2021

RECOGNIZING March 2nd as National Read Across America Day in Cincinnati in order to honor and express the importance of reading to youth and young adults, and further **ENCOURAGING** all Cincinnatians to observe this day by participating in appropriate ceremonies and activities fostering the joy of reading in their communities.




BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:
