AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation from Uptown Rental Properties valued at \$150,000 for fitness equipment, updated scoreboards, and other facility improvements at the Corryville Recreation Center.

WHEREAS, Uptown Rental Properties intends to donate items such as treadmills, exercise bikes, and weightlifting machines for the Corryville Recreation Center's exercise room, as well as updated scoreboards and new furniture for the facility; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the donation requires no matching funds, and there are no FTEs associated with the donation; and

WHEREAS, this donation is in accordance with the "Collaborate" goal to "[u]nite our community," as described on page 210 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept an in-kind donation from Uptown Rental Properties valued at \$150,000 for fitness equipment, updated scoreboards, and other facility improvements at the Corryville Recreation Center.

Section 2. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the provisions of Section 1 herein.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall, subject to the terms of Article II, Section 6 of the Charter, be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is

the immediate need to accept the donations and install the improvements and equipment as soon as possible.
