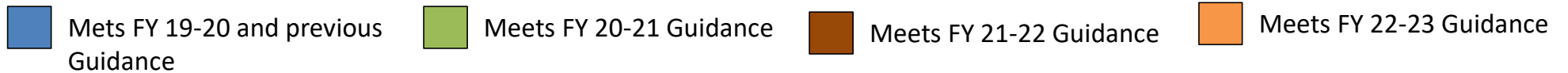


Complete Streets-Communities

GOAL: Support state, tribal and local policies that increase active transportation, community physical activity opportunities (including but not limited to parks, green spaces, playgrounds), and neighborhood or land preservation. At the state and local level, require that all road construction and reconstruction create complete streets that are safe and convenient for diverse users and all modes of transportation.
