Subject: ORDINANCE – GREEN STREET & PLEASANT STREET RPPA

Attached is an ordinance captioned as follows:

DESIGNATING certain portions of Green Street from Logan Street to Race Street and certain portions of Pleasant Street from Liberty Street to West Elder Street in the Over-the-Rhine neighborhood as a Residential Parking Permit Area, in which area parking will be limited to holders of residential parking permits issued by the City of Cincinnati pursuant to Cincinnati Municipal Code Chapter 514.

The Over-the-Rhine (OTR) Residential Parking Permit Area (RPPA) was established in 2020 to improve the availability of on-street parking spaces for residents. The OTR Community Council and residents have requested another RPPA to provide more on-street parking for residents.

Once the RPPA signs are installed and permits issued, parking will be restricted to those with valid permits during the hours posted on the signs. There will be two types of permits available: Resident and Temporary. The Resident permits will cost \$30 per year and the Temporary permits will cost \$5 and will be valid for two weeks.

The Administration recommends passage of the attached ordinance.
