Subject: EMERGENCY ORDINANCE – DEDICATING, ACCEPTING AND CONFIRMING
DEDICATION OF EAST MCMILLAN STREET AND AUBURN AVENUE

Attached is an emergency ordinance captioned as follows:

DEDICATING, ACCEPTING, AND CONFIRMING the dedication of certain real property as public right-of-way for street purposes as portions of the public streets designated as East McMillan Street and Auburn Avenue located in the Mt. Auburn neighborhood.

The City of Cincinnati has completed a road infrastructure project known as the *Auburn Avenue Improvements Taft to Gilman and East McMillan Macauley to Auburn* (the "Project"). DOTE has identified certain City-owned tracts of land located along East McMillan Street and Auburn Avenue that the City acquired as part of the Project that must be dedicated, accepted, and confirmed as public right-of-way.

The City Engineer has examined the Dedication Plat as to its technical features and found it to be correct.

The City Planning Commission approved the Dedication Plat at its meeting on June 4, 2021.

The reason for the emergency is the immediate need for the City to accept and confirm the dedication of the Dedication Property and to record the Dedication Plats with the Hamilton County, Ohio Recorder's Office to establish the subject real property as public right-of-way at the earliest possible date.

The Administration recommends passage of the attached emergency ordinance.
