HISTORY OF FINDLAY STREET S.T.E.P.S. YOUTH

In **1945**, Findlay Street Neighborhood House was founded as a settlement house and neighborhood center in the former St. Barnabas Church. The Neighborhood House provided social services to predominantly low-income African-American families living in the West End. In 1961, the West End's Findlay Street Neighborhood House and East End's Riverview Neighbors House merged to become Seven Hills Neighborhood Houses.

Youth have always been at the center of the Findlay Street Neighborhood House. From the founding of Camp Joy, to establishing the first daycare centers in the City, youth have always remained at the heart of our work at the Neighborhood House.




