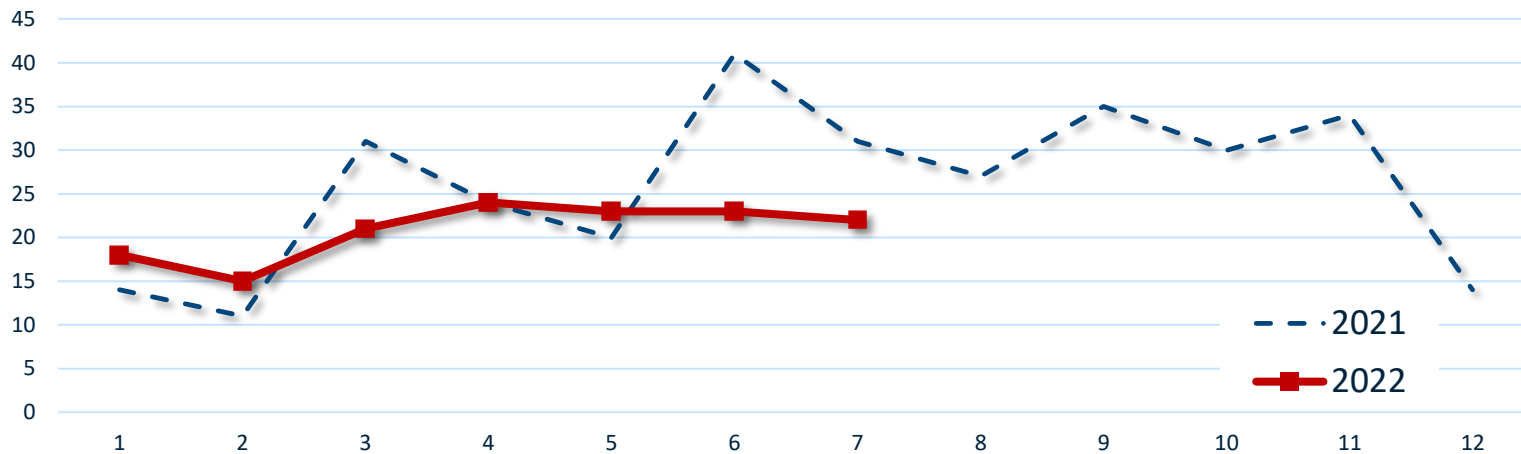

Year-to-Date*	168	146

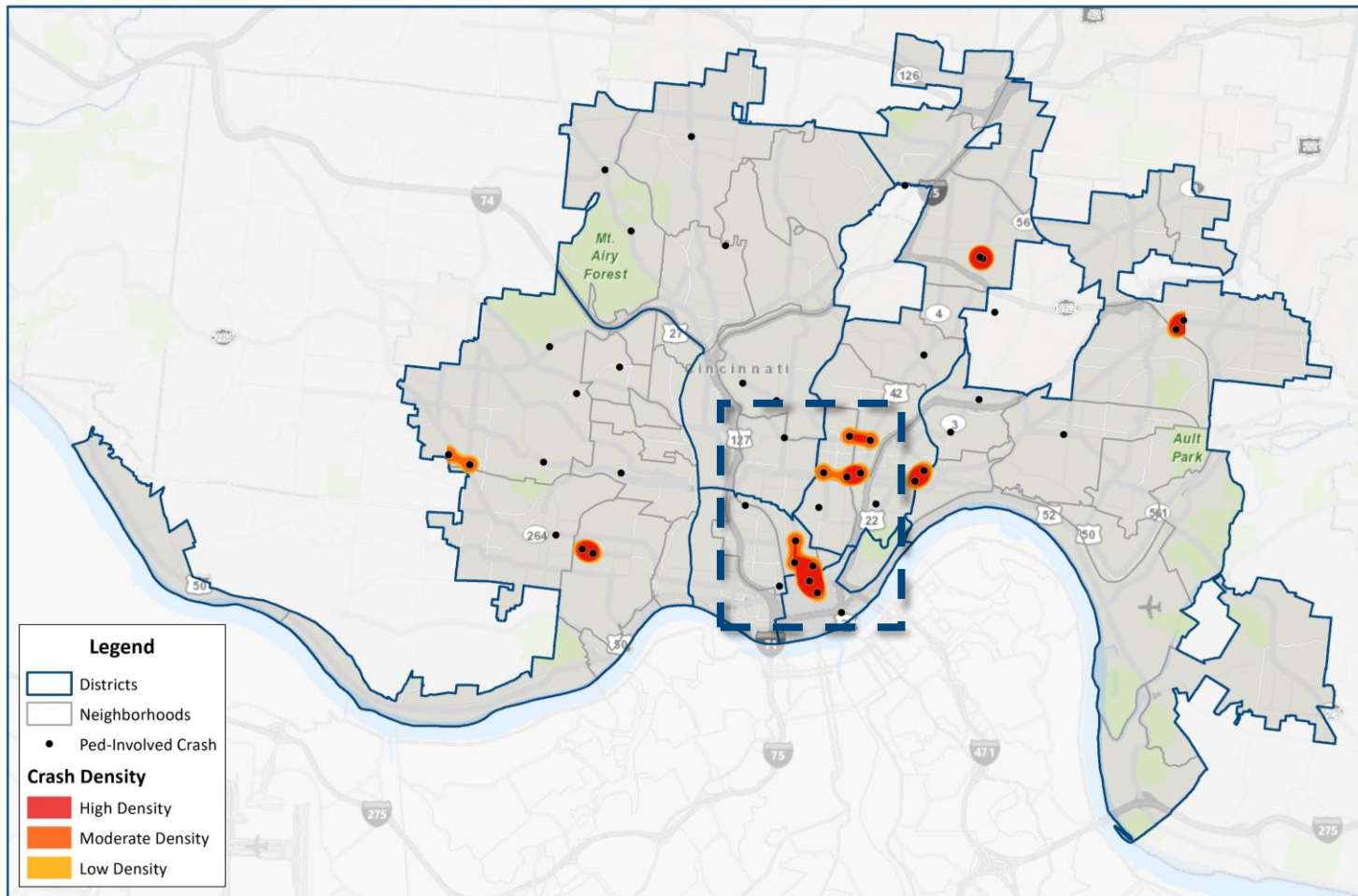

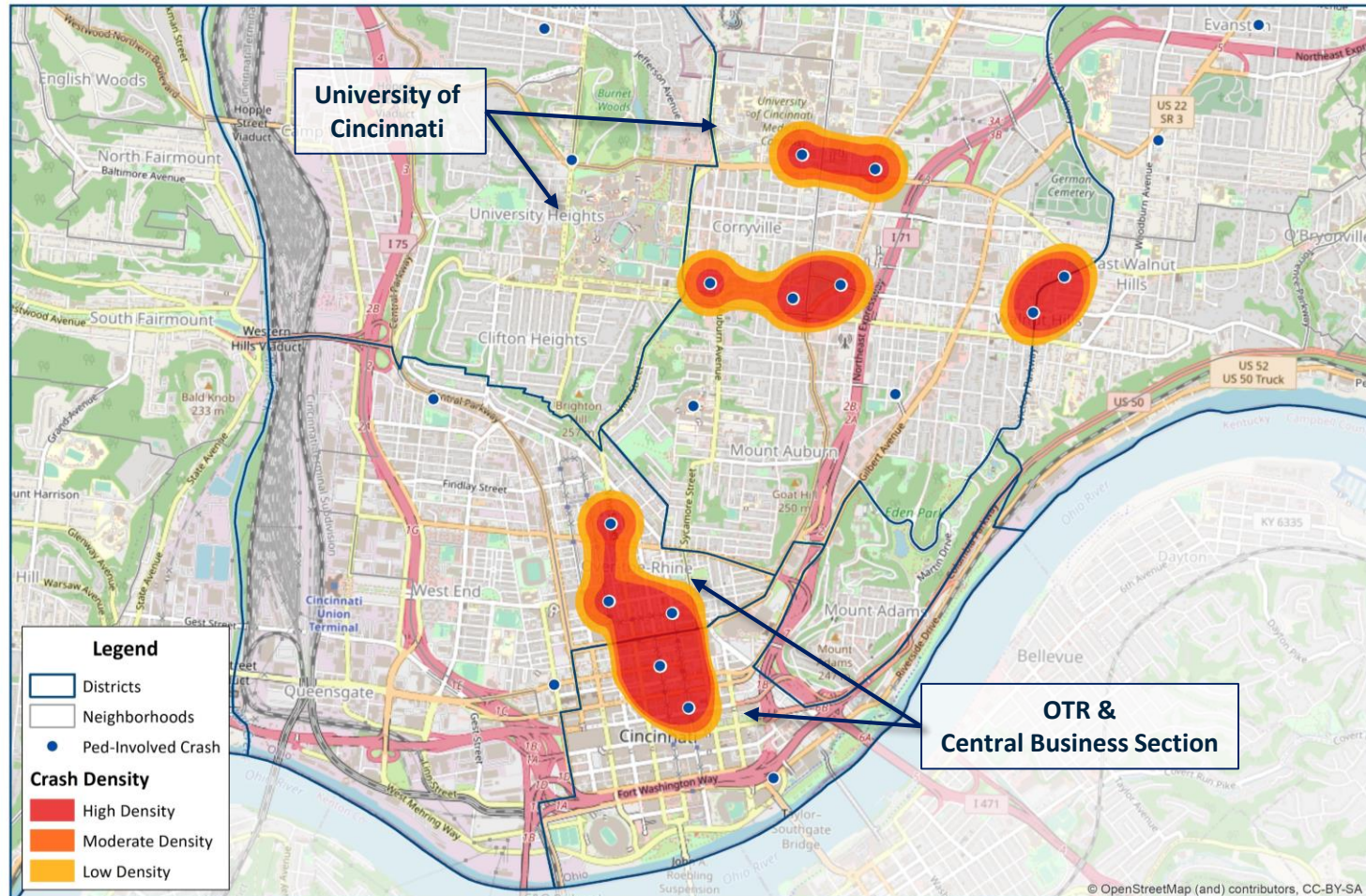
