Holiday Schedule

Service will not be impacted

Juneteenth

- June 19, 2026
- ### *Independence Day*
- July 3rd, 2026

Service **WILL** be impacted

Labor Day

- September 7, 2026
- No trash, yard waste, bulk items or recycling will be collected in observance of Labor Day. One-day delay for the remainder of the week.



Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste is collected every-other-week beginning April 20, 2026, through the second week of January and is collected on the same day as your recycling.

Important Rules:

- Place yard waste in clearly marked cans with handles, designated paper bags, or bundled with heavy twine or cotton
- Containers and bags should not exceed 25lbs
- Sticks and branches may be tied into bundles of no than 3' lengths and 2' in diameter
- Loose yard waste should be in containers that have lids or closed bags to prevent blowing

Yard Waste not accepted:

- Yard waste mixed with garbage or in plastic bags
- Logs or stumps thicker than 6" in diameter
- Dirt, rocks, sand or concrete
- Treated or processed wood of any kind
- Animal feces
- Don't place yard waste in your recycling cart, garbage carts, or plastic bags.

Accepted Non-Hazardous Waste: Yard Waste (including branches & leaves) Furniture (wooden, metal, sofas, mattresses) Electronic Waste & Household Trash Metal & Construction Debris Bricks, Concrete, & Asphalt Tires (limited 10 per vehicle each event)	Waste Items Not Accepted: Chemicals & wet paint Oils & other hazardous waste Refrigerant/CFG-containing items (air conditioner, refrigerator) Compressed gas canisters	Restrictions: ONLY City of Cincinnati Residents proof of residency required Vehicle Limitations NO trailers over 8 ft., double axel trailers, box trucks 15 ft. or larger, or dump trucks
