STATEMENT

Sadly, a young child was lost yesterday on this portion of Vine Street. Statistically, accidents are frequent in this area of Vine Street.

This segment of Vine Street connects UC and uptown hospitals with I-75. In my own experience and observation, high volume speeding is a regular occurrence in this area. Vine Street in this vicinity also has curves and hills which aggravate traffic conditions.

For sure speed limit enforcement is necessary. Physical improvements to Vine Street also is needed.

Immediate action is warranted.
