The City's grant applications should also seek out funding for workforce development in preparation for projects that will be coming, in fields such as welding, electric work, carpentry, and other career paths that are expected to expand with the new available funding. 3. Engage with Metro regarding the Reinventing Metro introduction of Bus Rapid Transit to the region, while ensuring that the needs of the community are met. 4. The City should pursue grants to support the maintenance, operation, and planning of the streetcar. 5. Promotion of green programs, particularly green transit such as bicycles, buses, and electric vehicles. Cincinnatians should be able to access multimodal transit and access other areas of the City without having to drive a car.
