

City of Cincinnati An Ordinance No.

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to apply for, accept, and appropriate a grant in an amount of up to \$150,000 from the HealthPath Foundation of Ohio for the purpose of providing support for the establishment of an interprofessional, collaborative practice to integrate oral health care with primary care for children ages 0-5 at Cincinnati Health Department community health centers; and AUTHORIZING the Finance Director to deposit such grant funds into Public Health Research Fund 350.

WHEREAS, a grant is available from the HealthPath Foundation of Ohio in an amount of up to \$150,000 for the purpose of providing support for the establishment of an interprofessional, collaborative practice to integrate oral health care with primary care for children ages 0-5 at Cincinnati Health Department community health centers; and

WHEREAS, this grant would provide \$50,000 per year for three years, for a total of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires no local match, but the funding and associated grant program income will support one new Dental Assistant beginning April 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Health Department ("CHD") applied for the grant on September 8, 2021, and was notified of a grant award on November 16, 2021, but CHD will not accept the grant funding without Council approval; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is in accordance with the Sustain goal to "[b]ecome a healthier Cincinnati" as described on page 181 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for, accept, and appropriate a grant in an amount of up to \$150,000 from the HealthPath Foundation of Ohio for the purpose of providing support for the establishment of an interprofessional, collaborative practice to integrate oral health care with primary care for children ages 0-5 at Cincinnati Health Department community health centers.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to deposit the grant funds into Public Health Research Fund 350.

Section 3.	That the proper City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and
proper to carry ou	Sections 1 and 2 hereof.
Section 4.	That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest
period allowed by law.
