

## City of Cincinnati Ant (1)rdutantr Ant. 459

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount up to $\$ 10,000$ from the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation for the purpose of providing funding support to youth sports programs in need; and AUTHORIZING the Director of Finance to deposit the donated funds into Fund 319, "Contributions for Recreation Purposes."

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation received a grant in the amount of up to $\$ 10,000$ from the Dick's Sporting Goods Foundation Sports Matter Community Grant Program to fund youth sports programs in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation is granting the funds to the Cincinnati Recreation Commission to provide funding support to youth sports programs in need; and

WHEREAS, the funds will provide $\$ 5,000$ in resources for the Price Hill Community Center, and \$5,000 in resources for the Millvale Community Center; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant requires no matching funds, and there are no FTEs associated with the grant; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the grant funding is in accordance with the "Live" goal to "[c]reate a more livable community" as described on page 156 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:
Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount of up to $\$ 10,000$ from the Cincinnati Recreation Foundation for the purpose of providing funding support to youth sports programs in need.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to receive and deposit the grant funds into Fund 319, "Contributions for Recreation Purposes."

Section 3. That the proper City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the terms of Sections 1 and 2 hereof.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
