An Ordinance No. 460

- 2021

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to execute a *Retail Water Service Agreement* between the City of Cincinnati and the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of Cincinnati ("City") provides retail water service to the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio ("Woodlawn") pursuant to an agreement dated October 12, 1987 (as amended, the "Current Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Current Contract term will expire December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City and Woodlawn desire to enter into a new agreement, in a form substantially similar to Attachment A, for the City to provide retail water service to Woodlawn for 25 years with the rate differential of 1.25 times the rate for City residents; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a *Retail Water Service Agreement* between the City of Cincinnati and the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio for the City to provide retail water service to Woodlawn, which agreement shall be in substantially the same form as Attachment A attached hereto ("Agreement").

Section 2. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the terms of the Agreement.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall, subject to the terms of Article II, Section 6 of the Charter, be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to execute the Agreement to enable the City to continue to provide water

service to the Village of Woodlawn, Ohio beyond the December 31, 2021 expiration date of the current contract.
