An Ordinance Ao. 170

AUTHORIZING the City Manager to accept an in-kind donation of a Chevy 5500 Super VAC Ventilation Unit originally valued at approximately \$194,710 from the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District to be used by the Cincinnati Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District has generously offered to donate to the City of Cincinnati a ventilation vehicle, a Chevy 5500 Super VAC Ventilation Unit, for use by the Cincinnati Fire Department ("CFD") to mitigate heat, smoke, or contaminants on scenes; and

WHEREAS, the ventilation vehicle, which was originally valued at approximately \$194,710, is equipped with a factory fan tilt, two 20-inch Super Vac fans, and two 24-inch Super Vac fans; and

WHEREAS, the ventilation vehicle was originally purchased with Urban Area Security Initiative resources administered by the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency to be used for regional preparedness in designated areas; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton County Emergency Management Agency has authorized the transfer of the vehicle to the City in writing as required by the original grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, CFD will utilize the vehicle for the purposes permitted under the original grant agreement, including making the vehicle available to the region in accordance with existing Mutual Fire Aid Agreements; and

WHEREAS, there are no new FTEs associated with this donation, and acceptance of this donation does not require any local matching resources; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of this donation is in accordance with the "Live" goal to "[c]reate a more livable community" as described on page 156 of Plan Cincinnati (2012); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept an in-kind donation of a Chevy 5500 Super VAC Ventilation Unit vehicle originally valued at approximately \$194,710 from the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District to be used by the Cincinnati Fire Department.

Section 2. That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to carry out the provisions of Section 1 herein.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
