

Background

- August 2013 City Council approved text amendments to the Cincinnati Zoning Code to create Urban Parking Overlay Districts (UPODs)
 - Urban Parking Overlay Districts eliminate all off-street parking requirements within the boundary
- April 2022 West End Community Council formally requested an Urban Parking Overlay Districts
- August 2022 City Planning Commission reviewed and approved the proposal





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Public Comment

- Virtual Public Staff Conference held on July 26, 2022
 - Notices sent to property owners within the proposed study area, to property owners within 400-feet of the study area, and the West End Community Council
 - Eight members of the public attended, including several members of the West End Community Council
- Letters of support from West End Community Council and West End Neighborhood Development Corporation

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
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Consistency with Plans

West End Speaks Plan (2016)

Future Land Use Map

- Linn Street identified as the neighborhood center of activity
- Proposed overlay aligns with areas identified for neighborhood mixed use and pedestrian mixed use



Analysis

- The West End is a dense, urban environment that promotes and encourages walkability
- The existing parking regulations:
 - Emphasize suburban development patterns in the West End
 - Increase the cost of redevelopment
 - Endanger the urban fabric and historic character of the West End
- Community council request
- Consistent with City-wide and neighborhood plans



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Recommendation

The City Planning Commission recommends that City Council take the following action:

APPROVE the proposed map amendment to add Urban Parking Overlay District #3: "West End", as outlined in § 1425-04 - Urban Parking Overlay Districts in the Cincinnati Zoning Code, to a portion of the West End.
