WHEREAS, Patti Collins further serves our region in her roles as a co-chair of the Hamilton County Oral Health Coalition, co-chair of the King Records Legacy Committee, and as a board member of Madi's House, a regional community center providing mental health and addiction support for young adults; now, therefore
