


Year-to-Date Shooting Victim Counts: 2015-Present






Rolling 28-Day Shooting Victim Counts: 18 Month Overview




Year-To-Date Gun and Non-Gun Homicide Victims: 2015 - Present




Rolling 28-Day Homicide Victim Counts: 18 Month Overview



Fatal and Non-fatal Shooting Victims across Cincinnati: Year-to-Date through 08/02/2020




Shooting Victim Demographics: Year-to-Date




Shooting Victim Demographics: 2019 vs. 2020*


Homicide Victims across Cincinnati: Year-to-Date through 08/02/2020


