**REPEALING** Ordinance No. 390-2020 in order to revoke the designation of Bellevue Avenue from William H. Taft Road to Oak Street located in the Corryville neighborhood as a Residential Parking Permit Area.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is appropriate to revoke the designation of Bellevue Avenue from William H. Taft Road to Oak Street as a Residential Parking Permit Area ("RPPA") upon finding that the RPPA designation has inconvenienced the residents of Bellevue Avenue and that the designation is no longer necessary to promote public safety, welfare, and convenience; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 390-2020 is hereby repealed, and accordingly the designation of Bellevue Avenue from William H. Taft Road to Oak Street located in the Corryville neighborhood as a Residential Parking Permit Area is hereby revoked.

Section 2. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to take all necessary and proper actions to carry out the provisions and intent of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
