## **Imagination Alley**



## **Imagination Alley Overview**

- City of Cincinnati issued RFP for Property Management in June 2020
- 3CDC was selected by City to:
  - Make recommendations for capital repairs
  - Manage the day-to-day maintenance and programing
- Project Cost: \$850,000
  - \$655,000 hard costs
  - \$195,000 soft costs
- Team
  - Community Engagement: Miami University Center for Community Engagement
  - Designer: MKSK
  - Developer: 3CDC
  - Construction Manager: Triversity



## **Imagination Alley**



## **Community Engagement**

- Extensive community engagement process has been completed working with MUCCE to inform the design.
- Key findings were:
  - ✓ Make space safe and welcoming
  - ✓ Need to be well-maintained
  - ✓ Enhanced lighting
  - ✓ New features centered around children and families
  - ✓ Keep existing arch/mosaics, and incorporate new art
- OTR Community Council voted to support the design.

### **Timeline**

- Construction GMP by April 23
- Start construction early May 2021
- Construction complete mid-July 2021




